


International tourist arrivals to reach 1.8 billion by 2030

Information about this guide

This guide will help you to complete the form *Visitor Visa Application (INZ 1017)* or the *Visitor Visa Application for Auckland Region Applicants (INZ 1111)*. It will give you information about coming to New Zealand as a visitor and help you to understand the requirements you need to meet if you want to visit New Zealand.

You should read this guide before completing the application form. The guide gives you information about:

- how to choose which visa you need to apply for
- what documents you need to provide with your application form
- what a visitor visa allows you to do.

Do you need a visa to visit New Zealand?

You do not need a visa to visit New Zealand if one of the following applies to you:

- You are a New Zealand citizen.
- You hold a New Zealand residence class visa.

Australian citizens and some other groups of visitors from overseas do not need a visa to travel to New Zealand. See 'Visa-waiver visitors' on page 3.

ESTA is an automated system that determines the eligibility of visitors to travel to the U.S. under the Visa Waiver Program. The ESTA application collects the same information collected on Form I-94W. ESTA applications may be submitted at anytime prior to travel, though it is recommended travelers apply when they begin preparing travel plans.










Mekong International Visitor Arrivals 2001-2014f



- This Invitation for Bids (IFB) follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in Development Business, issue no. 687 dated 30 December 2009 (revised by September 27th 2011).
- The Socialist Republic of Vietnam has received a credit from the **International Development Association** toward the cost of Vietnam Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Development Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this **credit** to payments under the agreement resulting from this **Package MOFA2: Building and Installation Online visa issuance system for Ministry of Foreign Affairs**.
- The **Ministry of Information and Communications (MIC)** serves as the implementing agency for the MIC sub-project and now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the Building and Installation Online visa issuance system for Ministry of Foreign Affairs. These systems are to be installed at MOFA Headquarters (Hanoi) and at other sites in Hanoi.
- Bidding will be conducted using the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the May 2004 World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines that meet the minimum qualification criteria stated in the bidding documents.
Qualification requirements for Bidders are:
4.1. Experience
The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirement(s):
 - Be active in information technology or related industry for at least 5 years. In the case of a Joint Venture, the Lead Partner shall be active for at least 5 years and each other partner shall be active for at least 3 years.
 - Have successfully completed at least 2 contracts in the last 5 years, each worth at least USD 500,000 for software development. In the case of a Joint Venture, the Lead Partner shall have led at least one of the two of the above contracts.
 - Have successfully completed at least 2 contracts in the last 5 years, each worth at least USD 1 million for the supply, installation, configuration and technical support of ICT hardware and standard software. In the case of a Joint Venture, the Lead Partner shall have led at least one of the two about contracts and participated in another contract.
 - Have successfully completed at least 1 contract in the past 3 years for the development of a web-based, government "e-services" software application. In the case of a Joint Venture, one of the partners must have been the Lead Partner for the contract.**4.2. Technical Capacity**
 - If awarded the contract, the Bidder shall be required to establish offices with adequate qualified staff for technical support and maintenance in Hanoi. 


