


### Air traffic flow increase



Security & Facilitation: Enhance global civil aviation security and facilitation


**Economic Development of Air Transport**: Foster the development of a sound and economically-viable civil aviation system

### **Enhance Global Security** and Facilitation



This Strategic Objective reflects the need for ICAO's leadership in aviation security, traveller identification, facilitation and related border security matters



## Annex 9 - Facilitation to the Chicago Convention



- Integrates functions of agencies related to border controls – travel documents, immigration, customs, quarantine, law enforcement, transport operators, etc.
- Requires <u>inter-agency</u> (and crossborder) <u>cooperation</u> to implement Annex 9 obligations
- Chapter 3: main SARPs related to traveller identification and MRTDs





### **ICAO TRIP Strategy Implementation**



- The Secretariat developing a Work Programme of the TRIP Strategy - in coordination with TAG/TRIP
  - results, targets and milestones
  - estimated resources and activities required to achieve the strategic outcomes
  - indicators for measuring success, and
  - attribution of responsibilities for all activities
- A Facilitation Section at the Secretariat, which will include the ICAO TRIP Programme.
  - Optimizes ICAO's resources
  - consolidates alignment with Annex 9 Facilitation

### **ICAO** and the UN Security Council



## Agreement between the United Nations and the International Civil Aviation Organization

(13 May 1947)

#### Article VII: Assistance to the Security Council

The International Civil Aviation Organization agrees to co-operate with the Economic and Social Council in furnishing such information and rendering such assistance to the Security Council as that Council may request, including assistance in carrying out decisions of the Security Council for the maintenance or restoration of international peace and security

## UN CT Strategy and Resolutions



#### **Security Council Resolution 1373 (2001)**

The Security Council,

- 2. Decides also that all States shall:
- (g) <u>Prevent the movement of terrorists</u> or terrorist groups by **effective border** controls and controls on issuance of identity papers and travel documents, and through measures for preventing counterfeiting, forgery or fraudulent use of identity papers and travel documents.

#### **Security Council Resolution 1624 (2005)**

The Security Council,

2. Calls upon all States to cooperate, inter alia, to strengthen the security of their international borders, including by combating fraudulent travel documents and, to the extent attainable, by enhancing terrorist screening and passenger security procedures with a view to preventing those guilty of committing terrorist acts from entering their territory

### UN CT Strategy and Resolutions



### **NEW** - Security Council Resolution 2178 (2014) on Foreign Terrorist Fighters (FTF)

#### The Security Council,

2. Reaffirms that all States shall prevent the movement of terrorists or terrorist groups by effective border controls and controls on issuance of identity papers and travel documents, and through measures for preventing counterfeiting, forgery or fraudulent use of identity papers and travel documents, underscores, in this regard, the importance of addressing, in accordance with their relevant international obligations, the threat posed by foreign terrorist fighters, and encourages Member States to employ evidence-based traveller risk assessment and screening procedures including collection and analysis of travel data, without resorting to profiling based on stereotypes founded on grounds of discrimination prohibited by international law.

### **ICAO TRIP Relevance to UN CT Strategy and Resolutions**



9. Calls upon Member States to require that airlines operating in their territories provide advance passenger information to the appropriate national authorities to detect departure from their territories, or attempted entry into or transit through their territories, by means of civil aircraft, of individuals designated by the Committee established pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1989 (2011) ("Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee"), and further calls upon Member States to report any such departure from their territories, or such attempted entry into or transit through their territories, of such individuals to the Committee, as well as sharing this information with the State of residence or nationality, as appropriate and in accordance with domestic law and international obligations.

### **ICAO TRIP Relevance to UN CT Strategy and Resolutions**



• 11. Calls upon Member States to improve international, regional, and sub-regional cooperation, if appropriate through bilateral agreements, to prevent the travel of foreign terrorist fighters from or through their territories, including through increased sharing of information for the purpose of identifying foreign terrorist fighters, the sharing and adoption of best practices, and improved understanding of the patterns of travel by foreign terrorist fighters...

### **ICAO TRIP Applications**



### ICAO TRIP Global Implementation Assistance Needs



#### Challenges and gaps in developing and fragile countries:

- Weak **capacity** to <u>uniquely identify individuals</u> for the purposes of border controls, terrorism prevention and law enforcement
- Lack of robust identification management systems
- Identity and travel document fraud used for engaging in terrorism and organised trans-border crime
- Staff lacking competencies, skills and tools
- Lack of <u>trust and technical means</u> required for effective **inter-** agency and cross-border cooperation
- Inadequate traveller identification management and border controls
- Considerable mobility of cross-border populations

### **ICAO TRIP Implementation**



- Project: Strengthening Travel Document Security in the Sahel-Sahara (funded by Canada)
- Central America: 5 Gap Assessment Missions (funded by Canada)
- African Region Assistance projects under preparation with several Regional Economic Communities:
  - CEN-SAD: Community of Sahel-Saharan States, 28 States
  - COMESA: Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa, 19 States
  - ECCAS: Economic Community of Central African States, 10 States
  - ECOWAS: Economic Community of West African States, 15 Member States
- Consolidating partnership with other int'l/regional organizations: UN Agencies, FRONTEX, OSCE, SICA, INTERPOL

## ICAO TRIP Global Implementation – Initiatives Under Development



- Africa Region: Combating Terrorism
   Through Enhanced Passports
   Security, Identification Management
   and Border Controls
  - Project proposed to the UN
     Counter-Terrorism Implementation
     Task Force (CTITIF) and Counter Terrorism Center (UNCCT).
  - International Partnership
  - Total project budget <u>Phase 1</u>: USD\$12,386,098

- 36 States (Algeria, Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Congo, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Comoros, Cote d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of Congo, Djibouti, Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Liberia, Libya, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Nigeria, São Tomé and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Togo and Tunisia.)
- Also project proposals for Central Asia, the Americas (Phase II),
   South East Asia

## Vision for the Future



Establishing an ICAO-led framework dedicated to <u>providing</u> <u>technical assistance</u> to States in implementing the ICAO TRIP Strategy in the regions.

- Linking together:
  - States in need of assistance
  - Funds: donor programmes and development banks
  - ICAO expertise and partner organization's implementation capacity
- Objective: to provide a <u>one-stop shop for States</u> in need to access funds and expertise required for Traveller Identification capacity building
