#### LDS 2: The concept

- LDS2 will be a new and optional LDS, the current LDS remains intact.
- A central concept for LDS2 is that it will be a new version that will allow for optional data to be implemented as separate and individual applications on the chip.
- LDS2 will have three applications visas, travel stamps, and additional biometrics.
- The new applications are considered optional components of the eMRTD and can only be deployed under the direct policy control of the travel document issuing State.



#### Access Rights

Description	Read	Write/Append	Update	Delete
Electronic Visas	1	1 (incl.e.g.cancellation)	n/a	n/a
Travel Records	1	1 (incl. e.g. correction)	n/a	n/a
Additional Biometrics	2	2	2	2

- 1. States and defined organisations : as long as they are identified, they would have access. However, there is a possibility of denying access by a default allow policy with selective denial policy by States.
- 2. Defined states and organisations, default deny policy, requires specific authorization from Issuer or holder, a default deny policy with selective allow.

In this table 'cancellation' means that the data is appended with a record which indicates that a certain visa is cancelled.
