Vice President, Beihang University

Prof. Dr. Huang Hai-Jun has been the Vice President of Beihang University since December 2015. He was the Executive Associate Dean of the Beihang's Graduate School from 2009 to 2015, the Dean of the Beihang's School of Economics and Management from 2007 to 2009, the Vice Director of the Department of Management Sciences, National Natural Science Foundation of China, from 2000 to 2004. He received his PhD in transport operations research from Beihang in 1992. His research interests include road traffic flow models, transport network modeling, travel behavior analysis and congested road-use pricing.

He has published more than 200 papers in such international journals as Transportation Research (Parts A to E), OR, TS, JORS, EJOR, JTEP, Physical Review E, Physical A, Networks and Spatial Economics, and etc. In 1998, he got the Grant for National Excellent Young Researchers; in 2005, the Grant for Innovative Research Groups; in 2011, the national prize for Achievements in Natural Science; in 2012, the Fudan prize for Excellent Research in Management Sciences.

He is now on the editorial boards of TR Part B, TR Part C, JAT, Transportmetrica A, Transport Policy, and etc. As the vice president, he had served the Systems Engineering Society of China, Chinese Society of Optimization/Overall Planning and Economic Mathematics, Society of Management Science and Engineering of China. In 2011, he was selected as the IAC member of ISTTT (an outstanding, prestigious and time-honored authoritative conference in the field of transportation and traffic theory).
