Javier Vicedo is a Representative for the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) for China and North Asia since February of 2016. From this position he supports regulatory exchanges between EASA and aviation stakeholders in North Asia across multiple domains of competence.

Throughout his 20 year career in the aviation industry, Javier has worked in Europe, North America and Asia. He has held positions spanning from research and technology to business development and sales across various sectors including satellite equipment, military systems and commercial aircraft.

Preceding his work at EASA, Javier worked as Chief of Staff and Senior Director of Business Development at Airbus in China. Concurrently, he was also Chairman of the European Union Chamber of Commerce in China (EUCCC) Aviation and Aerospace Working Group.
