Mr. Parks is currently assigned as the AVSEC Training Coordinator for the ICAO Implementation Support and Development-Security (ISD) Section of the Air Transport Bureau. As coordinator, Mr. Parks manages the overall ICAO Aviation Security Training Programme. He joined ICAO in November 2001 and has served as the AVSEC Assistance and Oversight Unit Coordinator and Acting Chief for both the ISD and the Coordinated Assistance and Development Sections. In 1983 he joined the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) inspecting and investigating airport/air carrier compliance, transportation of dangerous goods and other violations of US civil code. From 1986 to 2001, he was an FAA International Security Specialist for the European, African and Middle East Regions and a Civil Aviation Security Liaison Attaché for the Nordic and Baltic Regions. Finally he was a Team Leader for the FAA Security staff that conducted the special assessment programme for security systems with an emphasis on international security operations. Prior to his service with the US Federal government, he was employed by the City of Chicago as an Airport Operations Supervisor at O'Hare International Airport. Mr. Parks holds degrees from Purdue University in Airport Operations Management and Aircraft Maintenance.
