Vision

 A global aviation community that has sufficient competent human resources to support a safe, secure and sustainable air transportation system.



Mission

 To bring together States, educational institutions, UN and other actors to attract and educate the next generation of aviation professionals and retain a competent workforce capable of meeting the needs and challenges of the global aviation community into the future.

- Published the Global and Regional 20-year Forecasts for Pilots, Maintenance Personnel, Air Traffic Controllers (Doc 9956);
- Developed a Fundamentals of the Air Transport System CBT course.



NGAP: An expanded scope

- a) provide an internal mechanism for coordinating NGAP activities across ICAO;
- b) engage with UN organizations and government bodies (including the aviation community and education sectors) to promote activities that support the future of aviation personnel needs;
- c) work with universities and industry to identify and implement effective strategies to adequately prepare the next generation of aviation professionals; establish aviation as a desirable career choice of the future; and attract high quality students in the necessary numbers to meet the industry's future needs;
- d) interact with the **research** community to develop solutions to address current and future global aviation challenges and to support aviation planning and development; and
- e) develop tools and provisions for ICAO Member States and the international civil aviation community that will assist them in implementing effective strategies to attract, educate and retain the next generation of civil aviation professionals.
