
The Need for Modernisation of ANSPs

- →HQ in Amsterdam with offices in Brussels, Montreal and Singapore.




## Positioning of CANSO

- From disjointed ATM systems to internationally harmonised and interoperable ATM systems








### Not necessarily more costly....

## Example of ANSPs working together to harness technology

- ✓ CANSO and IATA collaborating with regional ANSPs under the auspices of ICAO to provide full ADS-B coverage over the South China Sea
- Safety, capacity and efficiency will be greatly enhanced resulting in lower fuel burn and emissions



### Beyond the Hardware....

✓ANSPs have to become more business oriented and customer focused

Stronger governance structure - separating the role of the Service Provider from the Regulator
