Main Challenge

- For Multi-lateral UN Organizations
- Providing technical cooperation
- To low income economies
- In order to achieve minimum safety and security standards globally
- Thus, to save lives through reducing accident and incident rates in civil aviation
- Using most efficient and cost-effective means by sharing resources of States and partners

Major Technical Cooperation Initiatives



- Cooperative multi-State, multi-partner regional programmes
 - COSCAP (cooperative aviation safety)
 - CASP (cooperative aviation security)
 - CFP (cooperative flight procedures)
 - CAIG (cooperative accident investigation)
 - CAEMSA (cooperative aviation meteorology)
 - CAPSCA (cooperative aviation medicine)

Major Technical Cooperation Initiatives



- Country-specific technical cooperation addressing:
 - ICAO audit findings in States (non-compliance with Annexes to Chicago Convention)
 - Infrastructure upgrading requirements: airports, air navigation
 - Service improvements
 - Training capacity and capability enhancement
 - Creation of self-sustaining regulatory/oversight systems




