I have the honour to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the CAR/SAM Regional Bird/Wildlife Hazard Prevention Committee Tenth Meeting and Conference (CARSAMPAF/11) to be held in Asuncion, Paraguay, from 4 to 8 November 2013 hosted by the Civil Aviation Authority of Paraguay (DINAC).

The working languages of the Conference will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided if sufficient participants of both languages provide timely registration.

The Meeting will be carried without interpretation the first day (4 November) and will be attended by the CARSAMPAF Committee members and led by the Board of Directors. The Conference will start on Tuesday 5 November and will end on 8 November 2013.

This event will be of particular interest to pilots, airlines and airport operators, air traffic control services, aircraft manufacturers, national or regional authorities, private companies who work in aviation, environment, pollution, waste and legal aspects related to this topic. You are also invited to contribute to the conference programme with a presentation on a related topic and/or experience. It is recommended that the presentations be oriented to current situation, and the role of airport operators regarding the management and control of bird hazards and wildlife; Safety Management System (SMS) on bird hazard and wildlife prevention; share experiences on actions and best practices for better control of wildlife at airports and any presentation that you consider appropriate for the event.

I would appreciate confirming your intention to support the conference with a presentation no later than **21 October 2013**, by informing the name of the speaker and title of the presentation. For your information 30 minutes are being allocated for presentations and 10 minutes for its discussion. All presentations should be submitted to this ICAO Regional Office by **25 October 2013**.
