Agenda Item 1 Review and approve the RASG-PA ESC/16 Meeting Provisional Agenda and Schedule

1.1 The meeting agenda was reviewed and approved with additional agenda items as reflected in the historical part of the report.

Agenda Item 2 Review the February 2013 ESC Teleconference Summary of Discussions, including follow-up on RASG-PA Decisions and Conclusions

2.1 February ESC Teleconference Summary of Discussions

2.1.1 The Meeting reviewed and approved the February 2013 ESC Teleconference Summary of Discussions as final.

2.2 List of RASG-PA and RASG-PA-ESC Decisions and Conclusions that have been updated

2.2.1 The Meeting reviewed the RASG-PA and RASG-PA ESC Decisions and Conclusions. There were no comments.

Agenda Item 3 Status/update of RASG-PA Working Groups and Projects

3.1 Pan America - Regional Aviation Safety Team (PA-RAST)

3.1.1 The ESC reviewed the PA-RAST/12 Meeting draft report. The Meeting was held in Mexico City, Mexico, on 21 and 22 of February 2013.

3.1.2 Agenda items 7 and 10 of the draft report were amended as follows to clarify the outcomes of the PA-RAST/12 Meeting:

- Removed para. 7.6
 ~~“The Secretary suggested to use the same approach that RASG-PA and GREPECAS are using with the runway safety issues, the operational side is handled by RASG-PA while the infrastructure side is done by GREPECAS.”~~
- Changed 10.1 c) to state “utilize” instead of “adopt”
- 10.1 e) RASG-PA to provide US\$ 3,200 for training video
- 10.1 k) Changed to reflect LHD issue belongs to GREPECAS

3.2 Annual Safety Report Team (ASRT)

3.2.1 The ASR will be sent to States within the next few days for “Fast Track” approval of final changes to ASR.

3.2.2 The ESC agreed to develop high-level principles that would guide improvements to future versions of the report.

RASG-PA/ESC/16/1 RASG-PA ANNUAL SAFETY REPORT HIGH-LEVEL PRINCIPLES

The RASG-PA ESC will develop high-level principles to assist with production of the Annual Safety Report to maintain consistency with stated objectives to provide data to support safety initiatives in the Pan American Region.

3.3 Aviation Safety Training Team (ASTT)

3.3.1 The ESC was reminded that the ASTT/4 Meeting summary of discussions was disseminated to the ESC and States on 8 March.

3.3.2 The report included recommended actions for the ESC; no comments were received.

3.4 RASG-PA Project – Model Legislation for the Protection of Safety Information

3.4.1 The ESC agreed that phase one of the model legislation project is complete. The next step is to provide seminars for the States in order to disseminate the document and legal principles behind the initiative.

3.4.2 The first seminar is scheduled for Lima, 22 to 25 April 2013.

3.5 RASG-PA Project – FOQA Data Sharing

3.5.1 There was no representative from the project in attendance to provide an update.

3.6 RASG-PA Project – Central America Accident and Incident Prevention Investigation Commission

3.6.1 There was no representative from the project in attendance to provide an update.

3.7 RASG-PA Project – Standardization of Spanish and English ATC Phraseology in accordance with the ICAO PANS-ATM (Doc 4444)

3.7.1 Mr. Gabriel Acosta, IATA, provided the ESC with a detailed description of the phraseology course that is being developed by IATA. The intent is to develop a train-the-trainer course that would provide participants with the knowledge to provide standardized phraseology courses in accordance with ICAO standards.

3.7.2 The ESC asked for a breakdown of course development costs to be presented to the ESC for approval of funding.

3.8 RASG-PA Project – Bird Strike Reduction Programme

3.8.1 Mr. Santiago Saltos, ALTA, presented an update on the WIN-CAP Program (Wildlife Incident Neutralization Collaborative Action Plan). Mr. Saltos briefed the ESC that the USDA biologist noted improvements to both locations (Panama City and Guayaquil) as a result of previous recommendations. The biologists are planning to do a third visit, which consists of performing local training for airports, airlines and CAA personnel.

**Agenda Item 4 Fourth Pan American Aviation Safety Summit and RASG-PA/6 Annual
Plenary Meeting Logistics**

4.1 The ESC reviewed the schedule of activities for the week of 24 June 2013.

4.2 The Safety Summit tentative programme was reviewed, and the ESC made minor
modifications to panel participants and moderators.

Agenda Item 5 Other matters

5.1 Review RASG/PIRG Presentation

5.1.1 Mrs. Martin presented the ESC with the presentation that will be delivered at the PIRG/RASG Meeting being held at ICAO HQs in March 2013 by Mr. Alex de Gunten and Mr. Oscar Derby, RASG-PA Co-Chairs. The ESC provided comments and the presentation was modified to reflect input from the Meeting.

5.2 Review working paper process

5.2.1 The Secretariat advised the ESC that the process for submitting working papers at RASG-PA meetings was not being observed and/or that working papers were not being delivered in a timely manner for translation or inclusion in the meeting programme.

5.2.2 The ESC agreed that timelines for submitting working papers were adequate and should be adhered to at all times.

5.2.3 It was agreed that working papers not submitted by the timelines established may only be presented in one language depending on workload by the Secretariat staff.

5.3 Pan American Region – State Involvement in RASG-PA

5.3.1 Mr. Carlos Pellegrino, Brazil, discussed the lack of involvement from other Pan American States. He recommended that RASG-PA develop a strategic plan of action to disseminate RASG-PA information.

5.3.2 Mr. Pellegrino agreed to draft a “RASG-PA Strategic Plan for Communication.”

RASG-PA STRATEGIC PLAN FOR COMMUNICATION

The RASG-PA will develop a plan for disseminating information to States to ensure consistent and direct communications with the objective of involving all States in RASG-PA activities.
