


ICAO developed the new Global Aviation Safety Plan (GASP) and the Annex 19







ICAO State Safety Programme (SSP) and Safety Management Systems (SMS) are key for improving safety



According to Annex 19, States must implement SSP and service providers SMS





Their successful implementation requires the free flow of safety information




It requires that the safety information and their sources be protected



But there is a need of change in the mindset



That is necessary for moving from a prescriptive into a performance based environment



The identification and reporting of hazards are essential



The risk management and the safety assurance are the core activity of safety management principles



The safety data collection, analysis and exchange may only be accomplished in a non-punitive environment



It aims to the continuous improvement of the aviation system



But there is a need of change in the legislative framework







