EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Working Paper presents available information at the On-Line Framework (OLF) (http://www.icao.int/usoap) on the activities related to the Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme with a Continuous Monitoring Approach (USOAP – CMA) carried out in Central Caribbean.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 In line with Resolution A37-5 adopted by the 38th Session of the Assembly, ICAO and member States carry out USOAP activities with a Continuous Monitoring Approach (CMA), the USOAP CMA objective is to promote global safety through States a safety CMA.
- 1.2 During the Fifth Meeting of the North American, Central American and Caribbean Directors of Civil Aviation (NACC/DCA/5) held in Port-of-Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, from 28 to 30 April 2014, the *Port-of-Spain Declaration*, which establishes the regional goals for safety and air navigation implementation was signed.

2. Discussion

- 2.1 The USOAP CMA will continue during 2015 as the foreseen calendar in Electronic Bulletin EB 2015/6 *Implementation of the ICAO universal safety oversight audit programme Activity plan* attached in **Appendix A.** The Plan covers an ICAO Coordinated Validation Mission (ICVM) for Bahamas (9 15 December 2015).
- 2.2 In accordance with Annex 19 requirement, during 2014 the ICAO NACC Regional Office organized a Regional Seminar on Safety Oversight Air Navigation Services (ANS) for the NAM/CAR Regions, in Mexico City, Mexico, from 12 to 16 May 2014. A Regional Workshop/Meeting on ANS Safety Oversight and National Continuous Monitoring Coordinators (NCMC) has been scheduled for December 2015.
- 2.3 Additionally, is been forseen to provide assistance at the request of States for the implementation of the State Safety Programme (SSP) and Safety Management System (SMS) in accordance with Annex 19 provisions and ICAO Doc 9859, which regional objective is to accomplish safety regional goals established in the *Port-of-Spain Declaration*.
- 2.4 In all USOAP CMA activities, ICAO Headquarters personnel, ICAO NACC Regional Officers and CAR regional experts participation is forseen.
- 2.5 In order to guarantee that the State system is appropriate to the level and aeronautical activity scope, States should implement an oversight safety system based on Critical Elements (CEs) from Annex 19, Appendix 1, which includes State policy for the systematic management of critical safety risks and accountability for the aeronautical community. It is fundamental to comply with these responsibilities for aeronautical operations safety.
- 2.6 In accordance with USOAP CMA activities the Effective Implementation (EI) percentage was increased due to the improvements on the safety oversight system reached by the Central Caribbean (C/CAR) States. **Appendix B** shows updated information on EI for C/CAR States, published in the ICAO website: http://www.icao.int/safety/Pages/USOAP-Results.aspx. In general, it shows that the Central Caribbean is very close to the Port-of-Spain regional goal, highlighting the principal areas of improvement as follows:

Air Navigation Services (ANS): lack of regulations and procedures, personnel and training

Aerodromes and Ground Aids (AGA): lack of inspectors, procedures, certification and training

Accident Investigation and Prevention (AIG): lack of autonomy, regulations to protect AIG information and procedures

- 2.7 The International civil aviation community has recognized the Chicago Convention as the global framework that establishes the basis for the functions, obligations and activities of a State carried out within other States jurisdiction. Therefore, States should promote ratification to additional international conventions in order to ensure that they are within the functions and contracted obligations framework.
- 2.8 In this regard, Article 3 *bis* of the Chicago Convention clearly specifies:
 - a) State's obligation must refrain from resorting to the use of weapons against civil aircraft in flight; and
 - b) State's right to require the landing at some designated airport of a civil aircraft flying above its territory without authority or if there are reasonable grounds to conclude that it is being used for any purpose inconsistent with the aims of this Convention.

3. Suggested Action

- 3.1 The Meeting is invited to:
 - a) take note on the activities carried out within the ICAO USOAP CMA;
 - b) Foster among the ICAO contracting States compliance with the ratification of Article 3 *bis* on International Civil Aviation Chicago Convention;
 - c) be prepared to receive the USOAP CMA ICVM or CSA missions according to the activity plan of the EB 2015/6;
 - d) support participation of the selected expert for USOAP CMA activities;
 - e) notify the ICAO NACC Regional Office of the assistance required for a safety oversight management system implementation in accordance with Annex 19 provisions; and
 - f) recommend other actions considered necessary.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ICAO UNIVERSAL SAFETY OVERSIGHT AUDIT PROGRAMME — ACTIVITY PLAN

- 1. The ICAO Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme (USOAP) Activity Plan, has been prepared in line with Assembly Resolution A37-5 directing the evolution of USOAP to a continuous monitoring approach (CMA). The Activity Plan encompasses continuous monitoring approach (CMA) audits, ICAO Coordinated Validation Missions (ICVMs), Off-site Validation Activities and regional seminars/workshops. Candidate States for audits and ICVMs are selected based on an analysis of safety risk factors, including previous audit results, the level of traffic in the State, and progress made by States in resolving identified deficiencies.
- 2. States will be scheduled for an ICVM and/or Off-site Validation Activity once an analysis of the updated corrective action plan submitted on the CMA online framework indicates that reasonable progress has been achieved. The scope and duration of the activities will be based on the level of progress reported in the different areas which were audited.
- 3. ICAO will also plan and conduct ICVMs for States that have a Significant Safety Concern (SSC), once information is received indicating that the SSC has been resolved.
- 4. States interested in receiving an ICVM in 2015 but which are not included in the Activity Plan may ask for a cost-recovery mission by submitting a request to the Secretary General.
- 5. The USOAP CMA was fully launched at the beginning of 2013 following a two-year transition. Since 2011, a total of eighteen audits, seventy ICVMs and fifteen Off-site Validation activities have been completed. Twelve audits and sixteen ICVMs are scheduled for 2015, with additional activities to be conducted as permitted by the resources in ICAO.
- 6. USOAP CMA seminars/workshops have also been conducted since 2013, providing ICAO Regional Offices and Member States with valuable information regarding the implementation of the USOAP CMA and the use of the CMA tools, including the online framework reporting system. In 2014, twelve such workshops were conducted and at least four are being planned for 2015.


