1. Introduction

- 1.1 During the Third Project Steering Committee Meeting (SCM/3) the meeting reviewed the financial situation as of 31 March 2014, based on the contributions, the implementation and budget line commitment. In addition, the estimated budget for the 2014-2015 planned activities was also taken into account.
- Likewise, during the third Teleconference of the Project Members, the Secretariat informed that as of 30 September 2014, there were USD\$283,778 available in the project and to complete all events including Go-Teams through 2016, the Project would need USD\$264,512, which will be divided between 11 Member States for a contribution of USD\$25,000 due in 31 January 2016. In principle everyone agreed; however the final review of the future 2016 events will be reviewed under WP/16 of this Meeting.

2. Status of the Project's Contributions

- 2.1 In 2014 the project received the following contributions: Curaçao, Dominican Republic, Haiti, Jamaica, Mexico, Trinidad and Tobago and COCESNA, and in 2015 from ECCAA.
- 2.2 The **Appendix** to this paper lists the contributions received by States, Territories and International Organizations for Project RLA/09/801 since 2011 up to 31 March 2015, as well as the breakdown and total expenses as of 31 March 2015.

3. Budget Line Implementation Status

3.1 Since 2013 until March 2015, Project RLA/09/801 has processed 36 missions of experts who have participated in 14 *Go-Teams*; it has provided 78 fellowships for events and carried out 7 missions of experts to provide support in events related to the objectives of the Project. The Appendix to this paper details the breakdown and total of expenses per Project member up to 31 March 2015.

4. Estimated Balance of the Project up to 31 March 2015

4.1 The estimated balance of RLA/09/801 Project up to 31 March 2015 is USD\$218,510, as shown in the Appendix.

5. In-Kind Support

5.1 Within the Project assistance missions, several members have provided support with subject matter experts. The Project has facilitated daily subsistence allowance and air tickets for these assistance missions. In this sense, Project members are urged to inform the Project the estimated cost of this support, in order to register the costs and quantify expert salary costs assumed by each Administration.

6. Suggested Action

- 4.1 The Meeting is invited to:
 - a) review the information provided in the Appendix of this paper regarding the financial situation of the Project;
 - b) adopt necessary measures to cover the cost of pending contributions;
 - c) recommend actions to stimulate the equal use of fellowships and missions in accordance with the detailed breakdown of expenses;
 - d) based on the 2015-2016 activities information (WP/16), analyse the need to for an additional contribution just as agreed during the third teleconference of the Project;
 - e) inform of in-kind support as detailed in paragraph 5.1; and
 - f) agree any other actions deemed appropriate.
