





# No Country Left Behind (NCLB)

The NCLB campaign highlights ICAO's efforts to assist States in implementing ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs).



The main goal is to ensure globally harmonized implementation so that all States have access to the significant socioeconomic benefits of safe and reliable air transport.



The NCLB effort also promotes ICAO's efforts to resolve identified Significant **Safety Concerns** (SSCs) through ICAO's safety oversight audits.





#### North American, Central America and Caribbean Regional Office (NACC) **Regional NCLB Strategy**

**Align with ICAO NCLB** specific for the North American, **Central America** and Caribbean **Regions and** Regional priorities

**Identified based** on percentage of **State Safety Oversight Effective Implementation** (EI%),

States in the NAM/CAR Regions were classified in three categories:

0% ≤ EI% ≤ 70%

70% < EI% ≤ 80%


80% < EI% ≤ 100%

NACC Regional Effective Implementation (EI) % Status

47.6% of the States have an EI% **below 70%** 

19% of the States have an EI% between 70% and 80%

33.3% of the States have an EI% over 80%








16.7% of the States in **Central America have an EI %** below 70%

50% of the States in the **Central Caribbean** have an EI % below 70% 85.7% of the States in the **Eastern Caribbean** have an EI % below 70%




**Central Caribbean — C/CAR**

**Intelligence gathering** with each State (NACC **RO and CAA Teams** accountable)

Coordinate and communicate data with DG and designated Teams (DG, RD and their technical staff)



Agree, at highest levels, tailored strategic plans and priorities for the next 2-3 years with each member States to meet their needs (DG, RD accountable)


