1. Introduction

1.1 The GREPECAS Air Navigation Deficiencies Database (GANDD) is the application for storage, updating, monitoring and reporting air navigation deficiencies for the CAR and SAM Regions. The GANDD follows the ICAO Uniform Methodology for the Identification, Assessment and Reporting of Air Navigation Deficiencies.

2. Discussion

- 2.1 The revised methodology for the deficiencies presented at the GREPECAS/17 meeting, through Conclusion 17/12 Revision of the ICAO Uniform Methodology for the Identification, Assessment and Reporting of Air Navigation Deficiencies, will be reviewed by the ICAO Air Navigation Commission (ANC) by December 2015 and as so, it has been included in the 2015 ANC Secretariat activity plan.
- 2.2 During the Third Meeting of the GREPECAS Programmes and Projects Review Committee (PPRC/3), IATA stated that it would send to the ICAO NACC and SAM Regional Offices its updated deficiencies list every three months so that each Regional Office may perform the corresponding actions accordingly.
- 2.3 In order to assist the States in resolving these deficiencies and within the NACC Regional Office NCLB strategy, the ICAO NACC Regional Office has coordinated and assisted the focal points on their action Plans and the timely validation of the evidence of the deficiencies solutions. In this regard **Appendix A** presents the status of the deficiencies of the Eastern Caribbean up-to-date in comparison with the status reported in the last E/CAR/DCA Meeting (2013). A number of deficiencies has been resolved and completed thanks to this activity. **Appendix B** presents the current GANDD focal Points.

3. Suggested Actions


- 3.1 The Meeting is invited to:


Outstanding Air Navigation Deficiencies by Priority "U", "A" and "B" in the Eastern Caribbean area (219)



Outstanding Air Navigation Deficiencies by Priority "U", "A" and "B" in the Eastern Caribbean area (202)





Outstanding Priority "U" deficiencies by field in the Eastern Caribbean area (6)




Outstanding Priority "U" deficiencies by field in the Eastern Caribbean area (5)


