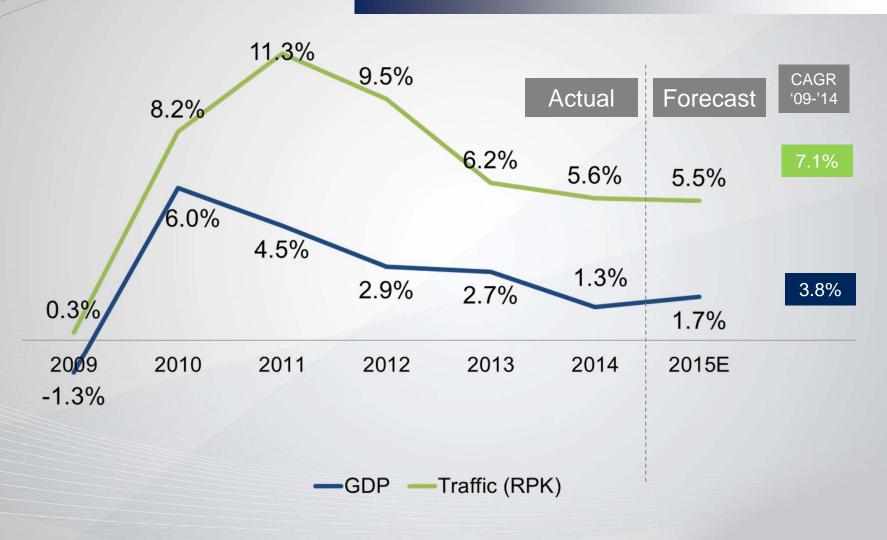

LAC Traffic and GDP Growth



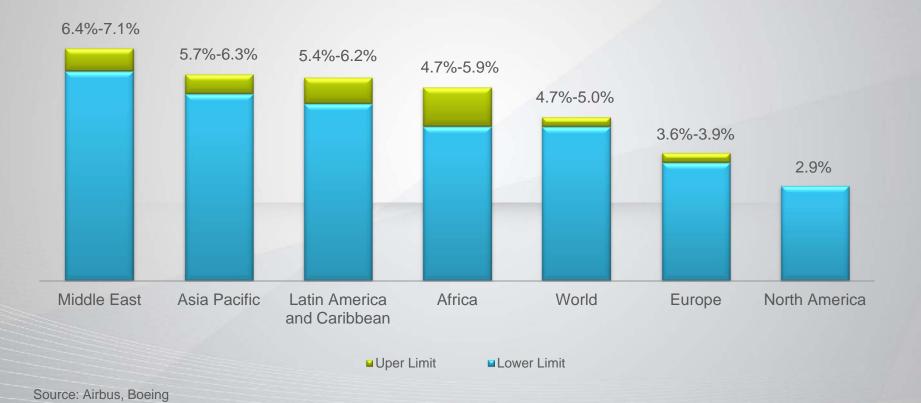

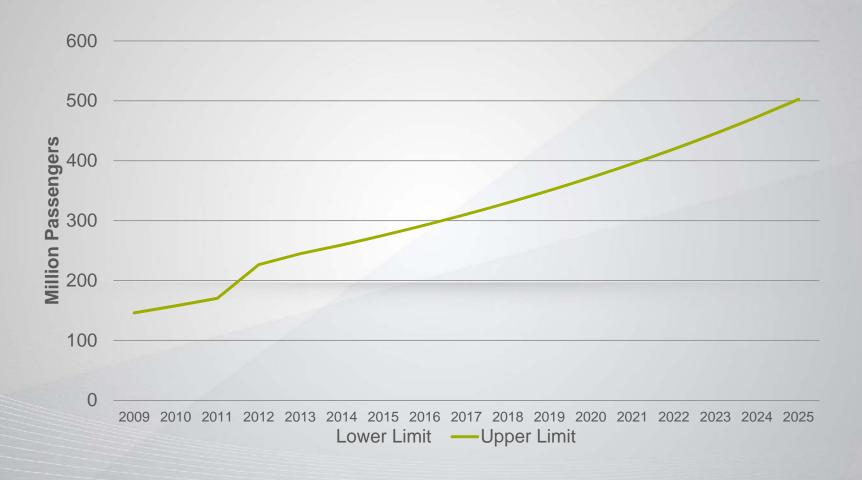




Long Term Traffic Forecast



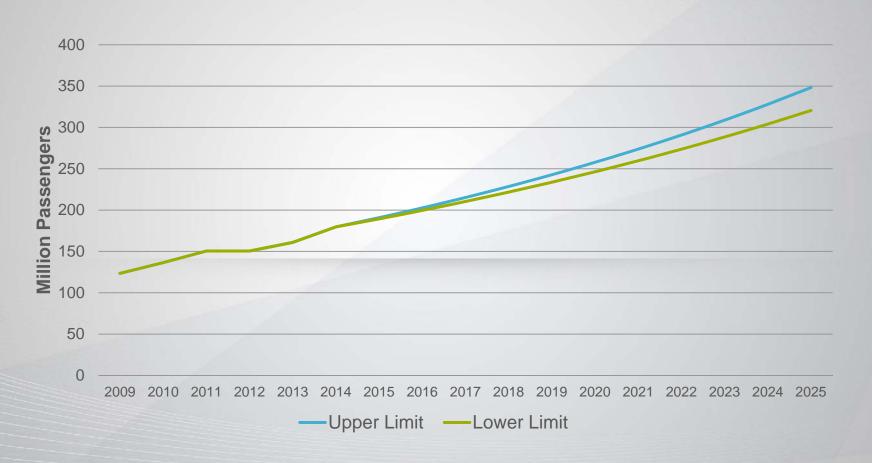
LAC Passenger Projections

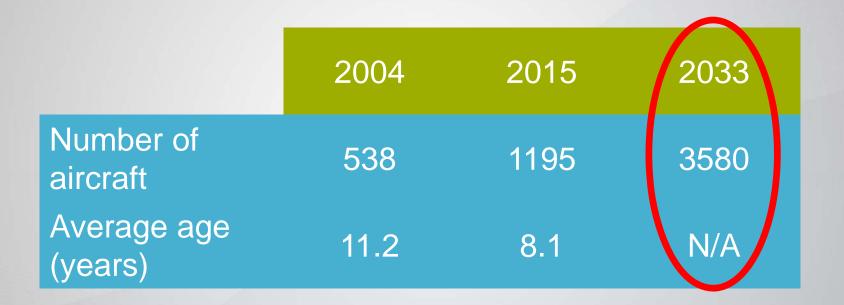

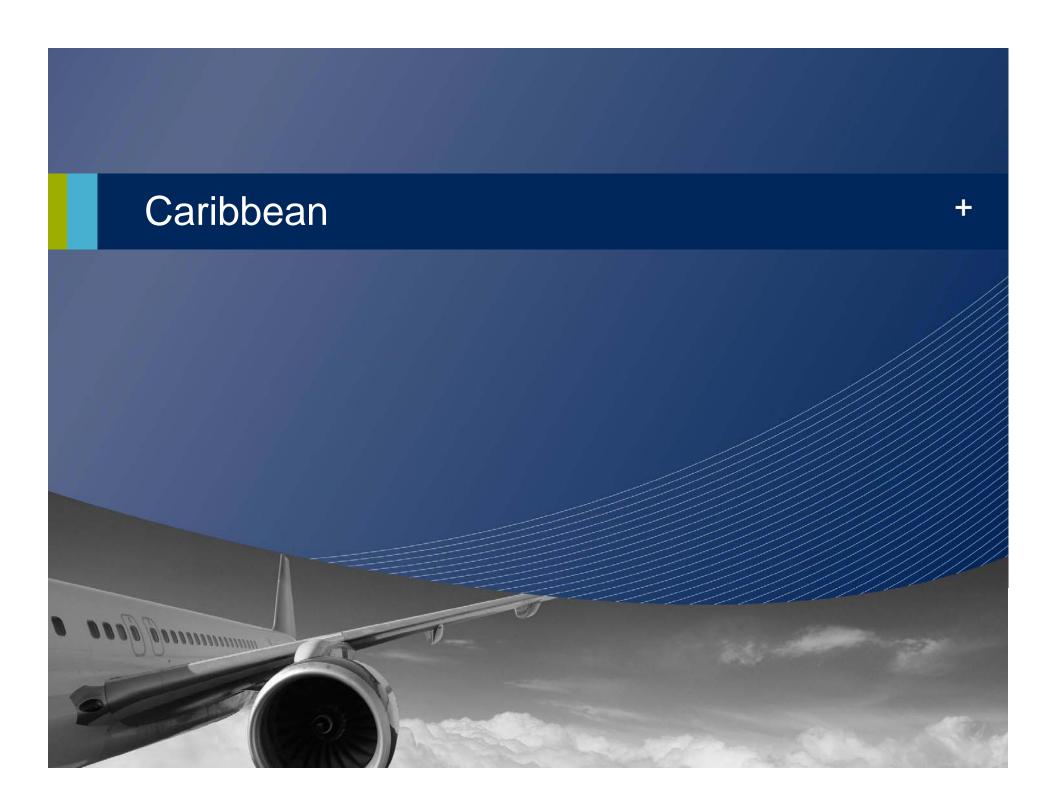


ALTA Airlines Fleet

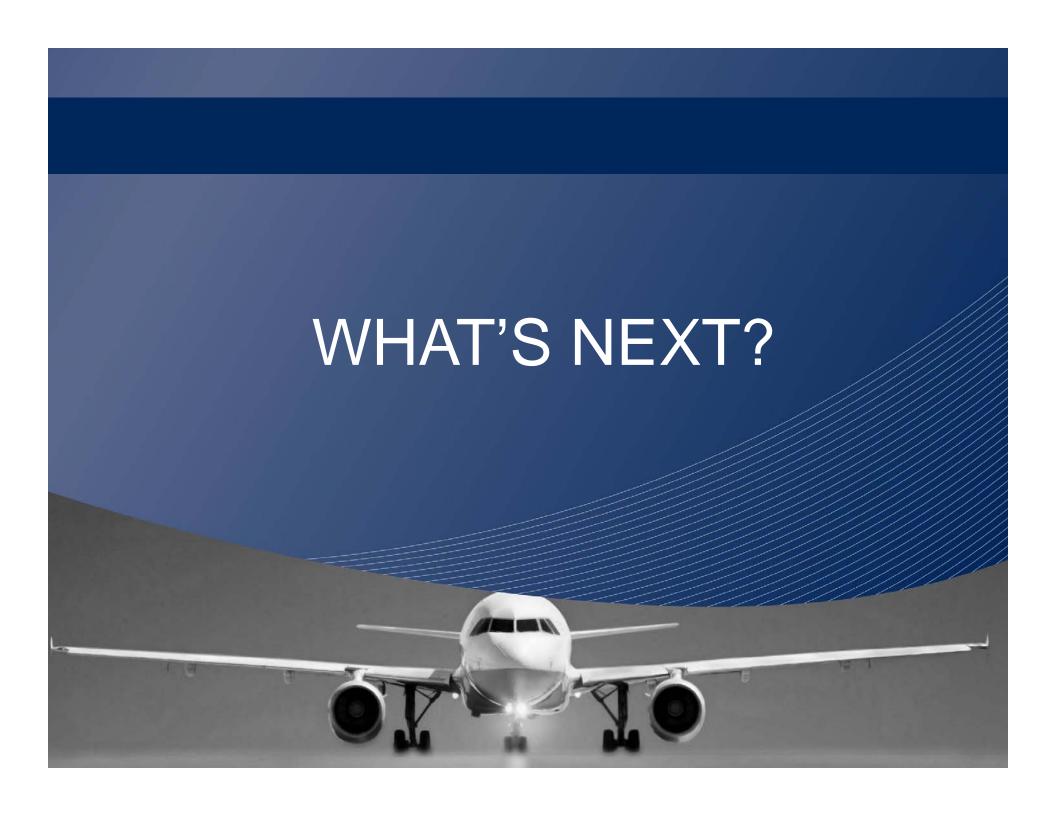

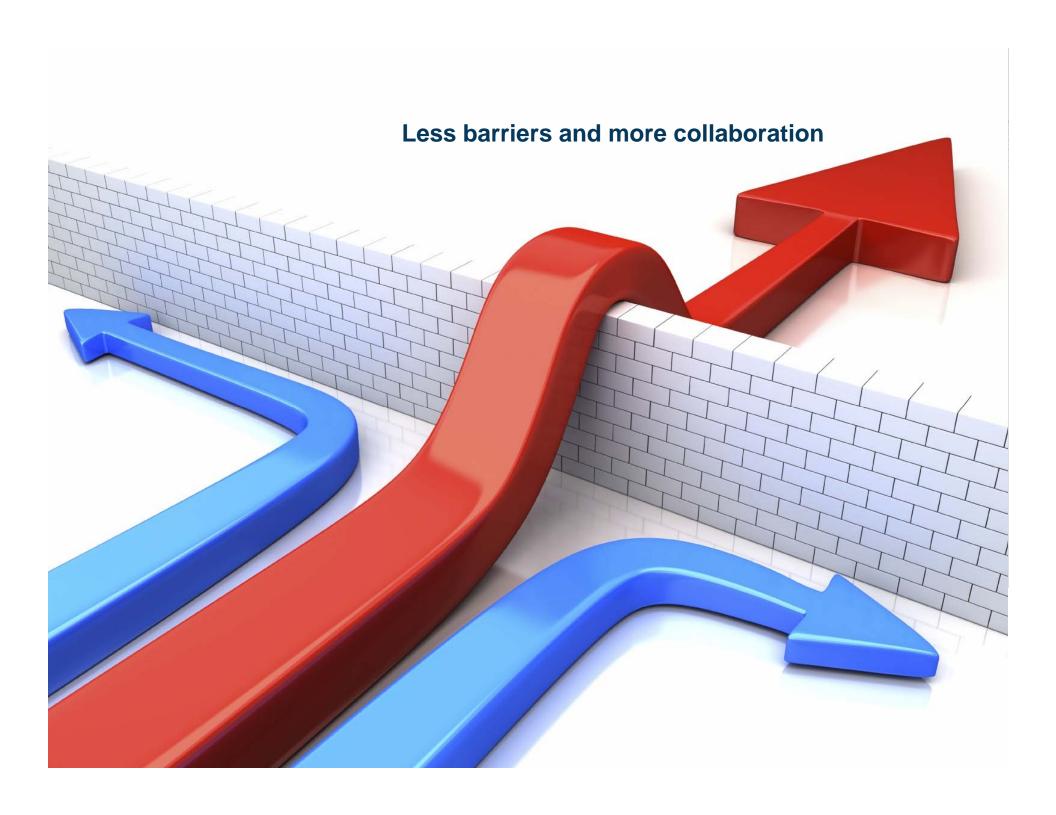
