#### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 The RASG-PA Secretariat is in charge of the administration of the RASG-PA funds, done by the ICAO NACC Regional Office Administration Unit.
- 1.2 Along the years, RASG-PA has received contributions, allowing the operation of the Group. Likewise, other States/Territories, organizations, and industry have supported RASG-PA activities by providing in-kind support, such as:
  - Hosting events
  - Providing subject matter experts
  - Sharing safety data and information
  - Promoting RASG-PA safety enhancement initiatives
  - Leading projects under the RASG-PA umbrella

#### 2. Status of RASG-PA Contributions

2.1 During the last two years RASG-PA received the following financial contributions:

- 2.2 For the RASG-PA 2016 budget projection, the Secretariat considered the proposal of the RSP-TF to reduce the number of RASG-PA teams and activities, which will be subjected to the ESC/25 Meeting approval (see ESC/25 WP/04). **Appendix A** presents the RASG-PA budget from 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2015 and the budget projection for 2016 is presented at **Appendix B**. The 2015 total expenses may change due to the fact that current RASG-PA mission has not been closed.
- 2.3 The following States/Territories, organizations, and industry provided in-kind contribution during 2015: Brazil, Costa Rica, Cuba, Colombia, Curacao, Chile, Dominican Republic, Honduras, Mexico, United Kingdom, United States, ACI-LAC, ALTA, Airbus, Asociación Sindical de Pilotos Aviadores (ASPA), Boeing, CANSO, COCESNA/ACSA, Colegio de Pilotos Aviadores de México (CPAM), IATA, IFALPA, IFATCA, Flight Safety Foundation, Aeroméxico, American Airlines, American Flyers, Avianca, Embraer, Embry-Riddle Worldwide Campus, Florida Institute of Technology, Florida Memorial University, Interjet, Johnson Controls, Nova Southeastern University, Spirit Airlines, United Airlines, and ICAO.

#### 3. Discussion

- 3.1 In the RASG-PA/ESC/23 Meeting, Boeing announced that its annual contribution to RASG-PA will change as follows:
  - US\$ 100,000 to RASG-PA discriminated as follows:
    - o US\$ 40,000 RASG-PA (ICAO NACC Regional Office)
    - o US\$ 40,000 (ICAO SAM Regional Office)
    - O US\$ 20,000 Pan American Aviation Safety Summit
- 3.2 Under the previously mentioned scheme, the RASG-PA Secretariat will continue to administrate the funds, and allocate them to the ICAO SAM Regional Office, for the execution of RASG-PA activities previously coordinated with the Secretariat.
