Introduction

- ❑ Assembly Resolution 38/12, Appendix D, identifies the scope of ICAO training activities:
 - ✈ Assist Member States in achieving and maintaining competency of aviation personnel through the ICAO Aviation Training Programme.
- ❑ Establishment of GAT Office effective 1 January 2014 (EB 2013/54)
- ❑ GAT Office Responsibility:
 - ✈ “planning, management, and coordination of ICAO aviation training activities to ensure the efficient, effective, and harmonized implementation of the ICAO Civil Aviation Training Policy.”

Achievements of the Global Aviation Training Programme

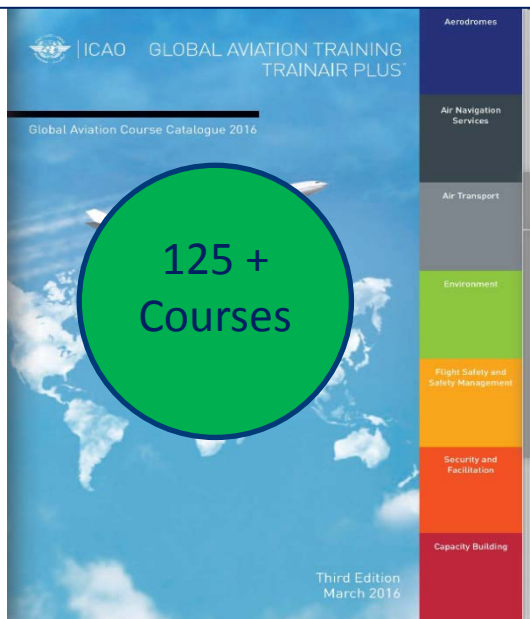
- ❑ **TRAINAIR PLUS Programme** (As of September 2016)
 - ✈ 92 Members in 87 ICAO Member States;
 - ✈ 21 Regional Training Centers of Excellence (RTCE);
 - ✈ 96 STPs;
 - ✈ 128 Courses – 590 course deliveries – 7800 trainees;
 - ✈ 16 Global and Regional Training Events.

Achievements of the Global Aviation Training Programme

- ❑ **Training Design and Development** (As of September 2016)
 - ➔ 20 ICAO Training Packages (ITP);
 - ➔ 3 RTCE ITPs;
 - ➔ 1 Compliance Training Packages (CTP);
 - ➔ New course: Validating Competency-based Training (VCT) Course;
 - ➔ 1 Partnership Training Package (PTP).
