This paper presents considerations for the elections of the RASG-PA Co-Chairs, States and Industry Representatives, in accordance with the RASG-PA Procedural Handbook, 4th Edition.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The RASG-PA membership includes all States and Territories in the ICAO North American and Caribbean (NAM/CAR) Regions, as well as all States of the South America (SAM) Region.
- 1.2 Membership also includes airline operators, international organizations, maintenance and repair organizations, regional aviation organizations, aircraft manufacturers, airport and air navigation providers, and any other allied organization/representatives.
- 1.3 The Membership, as well as observers and other interested parties, serve as partners of the RASG-PA, and their joint commitment is fundamental for having success in improving the aviation safety.

2. Discussion

2.1 Election of Industry Co-chairs

- 2.1.1 With a change to the RASG-PA States Co-chair, as well as the departure of the Industry Co-chair, and in accordance with the procedures contained in the RASG-PA Procedures Manual, 4th edition, elections will be held during this meeting.
- 2.1.2 The ESC members representing States/Territories and International Organizations/Industry shall propose their respective representative as Co-chairpersons for ratification by the RASG-PA ESC Members.
- 2.1.3 For the States Co-chair, the proposed State Representative is Brazil, and for the Industry Co-chair, the proposed representative is the International Air Transport Association (IATA).
- 2.1.4 The Meeting should note that due to the extraordinary circumstances of losing both Co-chairs in the same year, the Secretariat suggests that the procedure contained in the RASG-PA Procedures Manual paragraph 6.3 be waived.

2.2 Election of States' Representatives

- 2.2.1 The Meeting is requested to nominate eight States' representatives to the RASG-PA ESC.
- 2.2.2 The States' Representatives should be from four States of the NAM/CAR Regions, and four States from the SAM Region, in accordance with paragraph 7.1 and 7.2 of the RASG-PA Procedural Handbook.

3. Action by the Meeting

- 3.1. The Meeting is invited:
 - a) to note the information contained in this paper;
 - b) ratify the State and Industry Co-chairs, as duly designated by their country and industry representation at the RASG-PA ESC, to serve a three-year term;
 - c) to waive the requirement to avoid electing the State and Industry Co-chairs in the same year, and
 - d) confirm the States' Representatives to the RASG-PA ESC.
