



- LEG, ORG, PEL,OPS, and AIR were partially completed


## State Safety Programme PQs

Not yet completed – still on voluntary basis




# Situation of CAP by audit area






#### CAPs reviewed by ICAO, Last Updated On 19 Jun 2014






# Situation of CAP by Critical Element

## **CHALLENGES**

- Due to the size of the US government, coordination of updates to the USOAP CMA OLF can be challenging.
- ICAO often may lack adequate resources to process submissions in the USOAP CMA OLF system, especially when prioritizing submissions from states that have a relatively high El score
- USOAP CMA OLF is not intuitive for users
- Changes to PQs to include SSP PQs create significant workload for the US NCMC as well as the policy experts
- eFOD resulting from Annex amendments also can be time intensive to track
- Member States should support GEUSR recommendations for this group the training recommendation is important
