Accident Investigation (AIG)



AIG is one of the major deficient areas as audit results show



It affects most member States and Territories in our Regions

 Cost of having specialists and equipment to meet ICAO SARPs are not achievable by many States




An accident investigation group cannot replace the States sovereign responsibility in AIG but it would complement and enhance their capability and ability to meet ICAO requirements










Effective Implementation: AIG

Regional Aviation Accident Investigation Group (GRIAA)

RAIO initiative in Central America that has assisted Central American States in accident investigation

It provides AIG training and guidance

Currently obtaining funding

Lead person being contacted by the NACC Regional Office for the implementation of this initiative

Other ongoing actions

Caribbean Regional Accident Investigation Organization (RAIO-C)

Foster Regional Collaboration: TSB Canada, etc.






USOAP AIG Status: Belize

AIG is the third area less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: Guatemala

AIG is the area less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: El Salvador

AIG is the second area less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: Honduras

Number of Protocol Questions (PQs) in AIG by Audit sub-group








USOAP AIG Status: Nicaragua

AIG is the second area less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: Costa Rica

AIG is the second area less effective implemented









USOAP AIG Status: Haiti

AIG is one of the areas less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: Jamaica

AIG is the area less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: OECS States

AIG is one of the areas less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: Barbados

AIG is the second area less effective implemented











USOAP AIG Status: Trinidad and Tobago

Common AIG Status in the Region

Limitations / deficiencies

- ★ Lack of independence of AIG Authority
- ★ Lack of investigators
- ★ Deficient training of investigators
- ★ Proper and timely execution of investigations
- ★ Lack of reporting ADREP
- ★ Deficiencies in Accident Report Quality and timelines





RAIOs Development and Implementation

- □ ICAO Doc 9946 Manual on the Regional Organization for Accidents and Incidents Investigation (RAIO)
- ☐ Guidance to States on how to establish and manage an accident and incident investigation system.
- RAIO-C and GRIAA / States: implement an accident investigation Authority duly funded and professionally trained.
- ☐ USOAP: for target areas to meet SARPs in AIG



RAIO Benefits

- ★ Provide economies of scale by sharing the necessary financial and human resources for AIG
- ★ Promote regional training, cooperation and exchange of Safety information among RAIO member states for AIG activities
- ★ Improvement of the quality and quantity of the investigation of accidents and incidents
- ★ Improvement of occurrence reports Reduce the risk of death in the CAR Region
- ★ Create capacity in AIG per State -> Improving the results of USOAP-CMA



- ★ Safety Fund for Phase 1 of the RAIO-C
- ★ Work plan RAIO-C
- ★ Seek support in Training in ECCAIRS
- ★ Regional Collaboration Memoranda of Understanding
- ★ Hiring an AIG consultant for 6 months
- ★ Coordination with Mexico (FAM), Canada and NTSB for support in AIG

Working on Performance Gaps

RAIO-C/ GRIAA: AIG development and implementation –started in

- has been initiated, but was not completed as projected
- Missing agreements and implementation plans

2018 and onwards - AIG activities

- RAIOC/ GRIAA work programme s- harmonized activities and common tasks
- Support on LEG matters by ICAO: Regulatory framework harmonization Project
- AIG consultant hired
- AIG expert being provided by Mexican Air Force

Required ACTIONS:

- COCESNA/ CASSOS to discuss GRIAA and RAIO-C planning and common tasks and goals
- CASSOS Members to sign RAIO-C agreement
- Seek more support from industry/ stakeholders and other States
