PROGRESS REPORT ON ASBU TASK FORCE WORK PROGRAMME

(Presented by ASBU Task Force Rapporteur)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This working paper presents the progress achieved by the Aviation System Block Upgrades Implementation Task Force (ASBU/TF) since the Fourth NAM/CAR ANI/WG Meeting in Miami, Florida in August 2018. The major accomplishment of the ASBU TF was to assist States/Territory/Organizations to prepare their Air Navigation Plans (ANPs) with the support of the ICAO NACC Regional Office. In addition, the ASBU/TF drafted the North America ANP Volume III containing dynamic and flexible plan elements guided by the Global Air Navigation Plan (GANP)/ASBU and regional specific needs. This document is in the process of internal organizational reviews and the expected delivery to the ICAO NACC RO is in the summer/fall of 2019.

1. Introduction

1.1 The Aviation System Block Upgrades Implementation Task Force (ASBU/TF) was established during the NACC/WG/5 Meeting in Trinidad and Tobago in May 2017. The ICAO Global Air Navigation Plan (GANP) is designed to guide complementary and sector-wide air transport to future progress. The GANP presents the consensus-driven ASBU system's engineering framework for global harmonization of aviation technologies. The formation of ANI/WG ASBU TF reflects the importance of such advancements in the NACC Region. The objective of the ASBU/TF is to assist the region in the implementation of harmonized technologies that support the operation.

2. Background

- 2.1 ASBU/TF Web Page: The ASBU/TF web page was created and maintained by the ICAO NACC RO. This web page plays an important role as a communication facilitator and information sharing method. This page shares information such as NACC ASBU Handbook, ASBU Air Navigation Reporting Form (ANRF), ASBU Block 0 Implementation Status Summary Table Template, ToRs, and Work Program. submitted **ANRFs** be The State and ANPs can accessed through this (https://www.icao.int/NACC/Pages/regional-group-asbu.aspx).
- 2.2 State ANP: Saint Lucia and the ASBU TF Rapporteur collaborated to prepare the Saint Lucia State ANP in September 2017. The experience to create the State ANP, which has the structure to work together with the RPBANIP, was vital and provided valuable lessons. Using this experience, the process to create the State ANP was identified and the State ANP template was made. Many States in the CAR Region do not have a comprehensive State ANP aligned with the GANP/RPBANIP. Whilst, the use of this template is not mandated; it is available to assist States creating an ANP.
- 2.3 State ANP: The ICAO NACC RO and ASBU/TF Rapporteur organized the State ANP Development Workshop. This 1st workshop was hosted by the ICAO NACC RO in Mexico City, Mexico, from 12 to 15 March, 2018. Attendees were Barbados, Belize, Curaçao, Mexico, and COCESNA. The class size was small, but this size was perfect as it allowed the Development Workshop to provide sufficient attention to each attendee. Upon completion of the Workshop, all attendees created their State ANP in draft form, including all Block 0 ANRFs.
- Regional ANP: The NAM/CAR RPBANIP was updated to version 3.1 in April 2014 by aligning the activities and strategies with ICAO ASBU methodology/framework. The ASBU/TF supported the ICAO NACC RO to revise RPBANIP from version 3.1 to version 4. Since the last update of RPBANIP, the ICAO NACC RO studied the ASBU methodology/framework and found the better way to communicate the concept of ASBU, its intention, and how it can be applied to support the States. The RPBANIP version 4 provides realistic metrics and targets, a clear ASBU implementation process, and reporting mechanisms.

- 2.5 Regional ANP: The NAM/CAR RPBANIP covers both NAM and CAR regions. The ICAO NACC RO recommended to separate NAM and CAR in preparation of regional e-ANPs to reflect the geographical differences between them and adequate alignment between documents. This way, the ICAO NACC RO can better provide the required support to the necessary areas/locations.
- 2.6 Regional ANP: The NAM/CAR RPBANIP will become two documents. The CAR RPBANIP will cover the CAR region, while the NAM e-ANP Volume III will cover the North America region.
- 2.7 Regional ANP: The ICAO NACC RO representatives and ASBU/TF Rapporteur met on 15 and 16 May, 2018 and worked on the ASBU-related sections of the RPBANIP in preparation of next version. Canada and United States will prepare the NAM ANP Volume III under the guidance of the ICAO NACC RO.

3. ASBU/TF Progress and Results

- 3.1 Work Programme and Membership Table: **Attachment** contains the Terms of Reference (ToR) of this TF. The updated Work Programme and Membership Table are included in the ToR.
- 3.2 State ANP: The ICAO NACC RO organized the 2nd ANP Development Workshop for Central American states, hosted by COCESNA in Tegucigalpa, Honduras, from 6 to 9 August, 2018. Attendees were Belize, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua, and COCESNA. While Belize and COCESNA refined their ANPs from the 1st ANP Development Workshop, other first time participants successfully drafted their State ANPs.
- 3.3 State ANP: The ICAO NACC RO organized the 3rd ANP Development Workshop for Eastern Caribbean States, hosted by Barbados Civil Aviation Authority in Bridgetown, Barbados, from 6 to 9 November, 2018. Attendees were Antigua and Barbados, Barbados, Haiti, Saint Vincent and Grenadines and Trinidad and Tobago. While Barbados refined their ANP from the 1st ANP Development Workshop, other first time participants successfully drafted their State ANPs.
- 3.4 State ANP: With three ANP Development Workshops organized in 2018, 16 out of 21 targeted state/territory/organizations have successfully prepared their ANPs. Additional Workshop is considered in 2019. The goal is for all CAR states to have their State ANP.
- 3.5 State ANP: The ICAO has the "No Country Left Behind (NCLB)" initiative, highlighting its efforts to assists States in implementing ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs). The preparation of a State ANP provides the awareness of SARPs to implement certain ASBU capabilities.

3.6 NAM ANP Volume III: Guided by the ICAO NACC RO, the NAM region is working to prepare the NAM ANP Volume III covering Canada and United States. The final draft version of NAM ANP Volume III is prepared and it is in the process of obtaining the approvals from States's authorities.

4. Suggested Actions

4.1 The Meeting is invited to:

- Each State provides the ASBU/TF Point of Contact information. Primary PoC (minimum) and Secondary PoC (multiple Secondary PoCs are accepted) need to communicate with the ASBU TF Rapporteur;
- b) Each State must submit the Air Navigation Report Forms (ANRFs) for ASBU Block 0 Modules/Elements (Note: State ANP includes this information)
- c) Evaluate the progress of the ASBU TF detailed in this paper;
- d) Review and comment on the ASBU TF ToR;
- e) Review and comment on the ASBU TF Work Program;
- f) Consider participating in the State ANP Development Workshop when available; and
- g) Prepare and maintain the State ANP.

APPENDIX

TERMS OF REFERENCE AVIATION SYSTEM BLOCK UPGRADE (ASBU) TASK FORCE

1. Background

- 1.1. At the ANI/WG/2 Meeting in June 2015, an ad hoc group was formed to discuss metrics of the ASBU Block 0 implementation status, performance reporting and revisions to the Air Navigation Reporting Forms (ANRF), which will be used by States and Territories in the NAM/CAR regions. In the ANI/WG/2 report, this ad hoc group was named the ANRF Ad Hoc group. Their given tasks are:
 - a) For the NAM/CAR States/Territories to review and adopt the proposed new ANRFs for application by June 2016;
 - b) For the NAM/CAR States/Territories to assess their status of implementation and report to ICAO NACC Regional office by 30 July 2016; and
 - c) For ICAO to organize, by the first semester of 2016, a hands-on ANS/ASBU ANRF workshop to improve the use and understanding of the new ANRFs with the participation of CANSO, IATA, civil aviation training centers and air navigation planning experts.
- 1.2. At the ANI/WG/3 Meeting in April 2016, the delegates agreed to more active participation from their States/ANSPs to reflect their national priorities and users' main needs. They agreed to create an ad hoc group to support the review, follow-up and reporting on the achievement of the air navigation (AN) targets established in the NAM/CAR Regional Performance-Based Air Navigation Implementation Plan (RPBANIP) and in the Port-of-Spain Declaration. During ANI/WG/3, this group was named the "ASBU Ad Hoc Group".
- 1.3. At the NACC/WG/5 Meeting in May 2017, the delegates agreed that the ASBU Ad Hoc Group would become the ANI/WG ASBU Task Force (TF).

2. Objectives

To assist the region in the implementation of harmonized technologies that support the operation, the Task Force will:

- Develop effective methods to determine the regional implementation status of the ASBU Block-O elements and the performance monitoring of the Regional Air Navigation System, on a cyclical annual basis, as a regional input to the Annual Global Air Navigation Report and feedback for the Global Air Navigation Plan and the Regional Dashboard.
- 2) Assist NACC's States to formulate or update their National Air Navigation Plans by using a planning process to ensure alignment with the RPBANIP and the GANP.

3) Contribute with the continuous updating of the RPBANIP in order to maintain the validity, accuracy, and applicability of the Plan.

3. Responsibilities

The Task Force is responsible for:

- a) Work Programme Management;
- b) Coordination and support of the development and maintenance of State/Territory Air Navigation Plans; and
- c) Support the revision and enhancement of Regional Performance Based Air Navigation Implementation Plan (RPBANIP)

4. Working Methods

The Task Force will:

- a) Present its work programme containing activities in terms of objectives, responsibilities, deliverables and timelines;
- b) Avoid duplicating work within the ANI/WG and maintain close coordination among the existing entities to optimize use of available resources and experience;
- c) Designate, as necessary, ad hoc groups to work on specific topics and activities and organize clearly defined tasks and activities;
- Coordinate tasks to maximize efficiency and reduce costs via electronic means including emails, telephone and teleconference calls, and convene meetings as necessary; and
- e) Report on and coordinate the progress of assigned tasks to the ANI/WG.

All ICAO States, Territories and International Organizations which are accredited to the ICAO NACC Regional Office, as well as other stakeholders in the NAM/CAR Regions, are encouraged to actively participate. **Attachment B** lists the Point of Contacts.

ASBU TF Work Programme

Updated on April 17, 2019

This ASBU Task Force (TF) work programme covers the basis for the preparation and maintenance of State ANPs by each member states in the region. To prepare and maintain the State ANPs, States need to understand GANP/ASBU in addition to their States' needs in current and future aviation technologies. The State ANP should be used by the State to strategically plan what capability will be implemented and when to implement it.

Note 1: This document establishes a guideline for attaining ASBU NAM/CAR goals and will be reviewed periodically throughout the year. A formal review each calendar year shall be conducted during the ANI/WG and NACC/WG meeting so as to update/revise/modify its content for currency and applicability.

Note 2: The GANP/ASBU will be updated every 3 years with ASBU Block definitions maturing every 6 years. Thus, minor updates are expected every 3 years and significant updates are expected every 6 years.
