1. Introduction

- 1.1 The ICAO NACC Regional Office is responsible of CAR States air frequencies assignment with the objective to carry out an appropriate management and avoiding duplicity in the frequencies.
- 1.2 The ICAO NACC Regional Office uses a tool developed by ICAO and named "Frequency Finder", were frequencies to be assigned are loaded to assess its interoperability with the adjacent frequencies.

2. Discussion

- 2.1 Currently, the database with the CAR frequency information is not updated and in order to provide an adequate frequency assignment without interference issues it is necessary that all the States update the information of Lists 1, 2 and 3 that are assigned to each of them.
- 2.2 The Dominican Republic has published the required information for the updating of its assigned frequencies, nonetheless, is necessary that all the States review and update their correspondent information, available in the following link https://bit.ly/2R3222y.

2.3 It is necessary that all the States provide to ICAO the information related with the frequencies in force and those that are not operating.

3. Suggested actions

- 3.1 The Meeting is invited to:
 - a) Review the available information of the frequency lists 1, 2 and 3.
 - b) Send their updated information by 30 September 2019 in order that ICAO updates its database for the analysis and air frequency assignment in the CAR region; and
 - c) Any other required action.
