

POA: the Implementation Phase

Project-Oriented Approach (POA)



Implementation phase:

- Facilitates Global Roll-out
- Facilitates implementation of regional plans, in cooperation with ICAO ROs
- Consists of implementation support activities, in cooperation with ICAO ROs
- Consists of extra budgetary activities, in cooperation with the ICAO Technical
 Cooperation Bureau (TCB), ICAO Global Aviation Training (GAT), etc.

The Description

What it is...

✓ It is a mechanism to directly assist Regions and States with implementation through tailored support

What it is not...

✓ It is not an AUDIT; the supporting team does not have direct control over the implementation process within the State.



Objective:

✓ remove "roadblocks" with implementation



The RBI Implementation support process

• The Process:

PHASE I

Regional event - for the Region/or for a group of States in the Region

PHASE II

Go-Team - for the single States

The Phases

Phase I – Regional Event

PQs Analysis

- Identification of Regional/sub-regional challenges
- Identification of supporting experts





Questionnaires

 Deeper analysis of the challenges in the Region/sub-region

<u>Preparation for the</u> regional event:

- Preparation of the Agenda
- Preparation of the real case scenarios for the event





Regional Event:

- Introductory session (potentially with executives)
- Specific workshop sessions
- Identification of candidates for Phase 2

The Phases

Phase 2 – Go-Team

Selection of candidate State/s

- Based on the input gathered during Phase 1
- Prioritization strategy





Data collection

- Gap-analysis
- KPIs identified
- Identification of additional supporting experts

Coordination and on site visit:

- Preparation of the agenda
- Logistics of the event





Follow-up activities:

- After 6 month: AIM
 Implementation Project
 Plan for the next 3 years
- Go-team to assist and monitor implementation

THE ICAO AIM RECOGNITION OF COMPLIANCE





The Description

What it is...

It is a statement of support that ICAO provides to AIS that meet certain conditions and criteria

• What it is not...

It does not constitute authorization, approval or certification of an AIS; these activities are a State's prerogative

REQUIREMENTS STANDARDS

Objective:

Help AIS organizations in improving their products and services and facilitate States in performing AIM safety oversight activities



The conditions

The conditions and criteria that the AIS organization must meet include:

- It is authorized by a State;
- It has qualified and competent personnel who have undergone training that is approved/accepted by the authorizing State;
- It has an effective Quality Management System (QMS), acceptable to the Authorizing State;
- It has introduced a sufficient level of digitalization of products and services provided;
- It agrees to ICAO's Standing Rules for Recognition of Compliance; and
- It agrees to pay an administration fee for the ICAO review and processing of the recognition.
