- Provides flexibility in allocation according to needs;
- Encourages strategic dialogues;
- Opportunities for joint donor collaboration.


RM Platform (1/5) – Purpose and audience

 - ➤ All ICAO staff (with role-based levels of functionality) LAUNCH Q4/2019
 - ➤ ICAO Council States (password-protected and with limited functionality) LAUNCH Q2/2020

Resource Mobilization and COVID-19 recovery support - Considerations

- The implementation of the ICAO developed measures and recommendations regarding COVID-19 recovery lies primarily with States
- RM comes into play when States express interest in ICAO's support of their aviation restart, recovery and resilience implementation efforts
- RM needs active engagement of interested States in the process (e.g. developing proposals)
- More challenges for RM due to the underlying economic uncertainty caused by the pandemic
