| ICAO UNITING AVIATION Council Aviation Recovery Taskforce (CART)

- ★ As you have heard from the President and the Secretary General of ICAOs leadership is at the forefront of supporting each of your States.
- ★ From the development of guidance and coordination with World Health Organization, industry and your own representatives in the various working groups, to the organization of the assistance of the Regional Office specialists
- ★ The Regional Office has been accompanying your staff with implementation of 'Take-Off' guidance for international aviation, which has kept the health, safety, and security of the travelling public of paramount concern throughout.
- ★ The CART measures have guidance for the different actions of the State, industry, and other stakeholders in the aviation sector, to provide harmonized and orderly support of each other in the recovery and restart of aviation, where all the entire aviation community had been actively involved.



CART PRINCIPLES

- ★ The ICAO Council Aviation Recovery Task Force (CART) contained ten (10) key principles for a safe, secure and sustainable recovery:
 - **★** Protect People: Harmonized but Flexible Measures
 - **★** Work as One Aviation Team and Show Solidarity
 - **★** Ensure Essential Connectivity
 - **★** Actively Manage Safety-, Security- and Health-related Risks
 - **★ Make Aviation Public Health Measures**
 - **★** Strengthen Public Confidence
 - **★** Distinguish Restart from Recovery
 - **★** Support Financial Relief Strategies to Help the Aviation Industry.
 - **★** Ensure Sustainability
 - **★** Learn Lessons to Improve Resilience



UNITING AVIATION Actions carried out concerning COVID-19 pandemic

- ★ ICAO NACC Regional Office during the Pandemic period support NAM and CAR States through the following actions:
 - ★ Assist States with the business continuity of their aviation sector as well as with their responses
 - ★ to aviation aspects of COVID-19
 - ★ Provide emergency advice to States, Territories and International Organizations
 - ★ Provide a regional forum to serve NACC States to discuss and share actions and best practices
 - ★ Guidance to States and Territories on regulatory, operational and other implementation matters
 - ★ Guidance to States on regulatory compliance deviations
 - ★ Sharing of individual State/Territory decisions that may affect international operations
 - ★ Consideration of alternative ways of conducting ICAO business
 - ★ Funding support strategies assistance



NACC States and Industry Agreement for the Aviation recovery

Committing to the CART measures, North American, Central American and Caribbean (NACC) Directors:

- ★ agreed on the NACC Strategic Approach as an initial approach
- ★ will continue effective and timely communications, jointly with the industry and ICAO, to keep everybody updated on the evolution of the pandemic and its effects.
- ★ will continue optimizing efforts and support actions to restart and recover aviation due to the effects of the COVID-19 in the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions, and agree to support activities and application of the GIR, following-up on the progress of their Administrations through the CRRIC.



- ★ A gap analysis tool allowing Member States to self-assess their status with respect to the measures contained in the CART report and define actions plans.
- ★ The Public Health Risk Mitigation tool contains the CART Takeoff document measures applicable to States, airport operators, airlines, and other stakeholders in the air transport industry.
- ★ The tool was designed to assist States to monitor the Public health measures adopted when implementing CART recommendations.



- ★ The Civil Aviation Recovery Task Force (CART) report and the Take off guidance document contain, among others, 11 recommendations addressed to Member States:
 - ★ Safety recommendations: REC-01 to REC 03; working and update information about Related Differences (CCRDs) between their procedure and ICAO Standards.
 - ★ Public Health: REC-04 and REC 05: Global and regional harmonization of procedures is essential to strengthen public and passenger's confidence in air travel and to review the necessity of continuing the application of risk mitigation measures.



- ★ Security and Facilitation: REC 06 to REC 09: States establish a National Air Transport Facilitation Committee, systematically use a Passenger Health Locator Form to ensure identification and traceability, States strengthen their oversight system to ensure that these measures are consistently applied with the objective of protecting aviation against acts of unlawful interference and States should take measures to ensure that relevant personnel are provided training to identify and manage unruly passenger situations related to non-respect of essential aviation public health and safety measures.
- ★ Economy and Finance: REC 10; Member States should consider appropriate extraordinary emergency measures to support financial viability and to maintain an adequate level of safe, secure and efficient operations, which should be inclusive, targeted, proportionate, transparent, temporary and consistent with ICAO's policies, while striking an appropriate balance among the respective interests without prejudice to fair competition and compromising safety, security and environmental performance.






- ★ Information Sharing: REC 11; Member States should facilitate information-sharing and exchange on their actions and best practices by contributing to an ICAO database of measures.
- ★ Best Practices: Member States to share their best practices related to the implementation of the CART recommendations.


