1. Introduction

- 1.1 As a follow-up to the decisions emanating from the GREPECAS/18 and e-PPRC/02 Meetings, the Aerodrome Program F carry out the Project F2: Aerodrome planning.
- 1.2 Regarding aerodrome planning, it is important to note that Amendment 15 to Annex 14, Volume I, came effective on 3 November 2022, which establishes:
 - "1.5.1 Recommendation A master plan containing detailed plans for the development of aerodrome infrastructure should be established for aerodromes deemed relevant by States.
 - 1.5.2 Recommendation The master plan should:
 - a) contain a schedule of priorities including a phased implementation plan; and
 - b) be reviewed periodically to take into account current and future aerodrome traffic.
 - 1.5.3 Recommendation Aerodrome stakeholders, particularly aircraft operators, should be consulted in order to facilitate the master planning process using a consultative and collaborative approach.

- 1.5.4 Architectural and infrastructure-related requirements for the optimum implementation of international civil aviation security measures shall be integrated into the design and construction of new facilities and alterations to existing facilities at an aerodrome.
- 1.5.5 Recommendation The design of aerodromes should take into account land-use and environmental control measures." (Annex 14, vol 1)
- 1.3 In this case, the Amendment 15 to Annex 14, Vol I requires that a master plan, containing detailed plans for the development of airport infrastructure, should be developed for airports deemed relevant by States. The guidance, Airport Planning Manual (Doc 9184), Part 1, is intended to assist States and airports in planning the successful expansion of existing airports and the construction of new ones based on the guidelines established in an airport master plan.
- 1.4 The new version of Doc 9184, Part I, is in the final stages of conclusion, with publication expected soon.
- 1.5 For a consultative and collaborative approach in the process of elaboration of an airport master plan, it is planned to prepare a guide material (Guidance Material Airport Advisory Committees) under the GREPECAS, F2 Project, with publication expected in 2024.

2. Conclusion
