1. Introduction

- 1.1. Taking into consideration this first meeting AIM/TF/5 meeting and all previous meetings of the ANI/WG, based on the set ToRs and the activities of the AIM Task Force work programme, the ICAO NACC AIM TF's Action Plan is presented. - 2.2. Members of the TF may be divided into subgroups to achieve the set goals, nevertheless continuous reporting to the IAM TF Rap must be complied with, in order to have fluent communication within the AIM TF.
- 2.3. The members for the Subgroups must be chosen during AIM TF meetings and/or Teleconferences, consisting of active members of the AIM TF only, a max of 5 States (one member per State) and shall be proactive on the received task. Members are encouraged to participate actively.
- 2.4. Report from the subgroups must be shared in Teleconference meetings, nevertheless, this report must be made available to the AIM.
