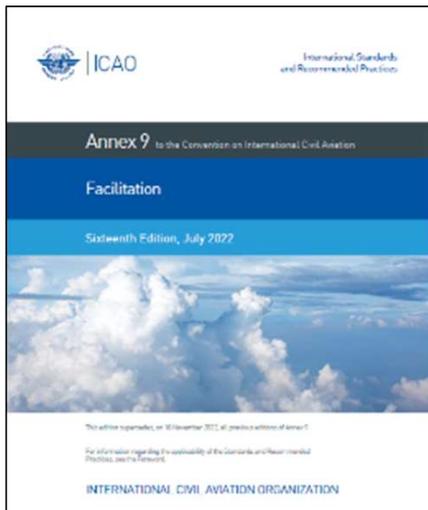
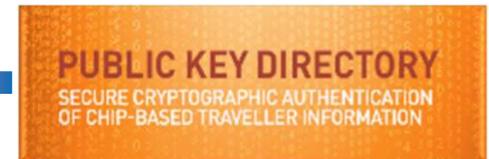

# — Annex 9 – Facilitation Policy Framework

## AMENDMENT 29 TO ANNEX 9 - FACILITATION

Contains new and revised Standards and Recommended Practices related to public health emergencies, security of travel and health proofs, relief and repatriation flights, air transport facilitation of persons with disabilities, assistance to aircraft accident victims and their families, trafficking in persons



Amendment 29 became effective 18 July 2022 and applicable on 18 November 2022

  - Assistance to Aircraft Victims and their Families - Recommended Practice 8.46 elevated to Standard 8.47 and new RP 8.48

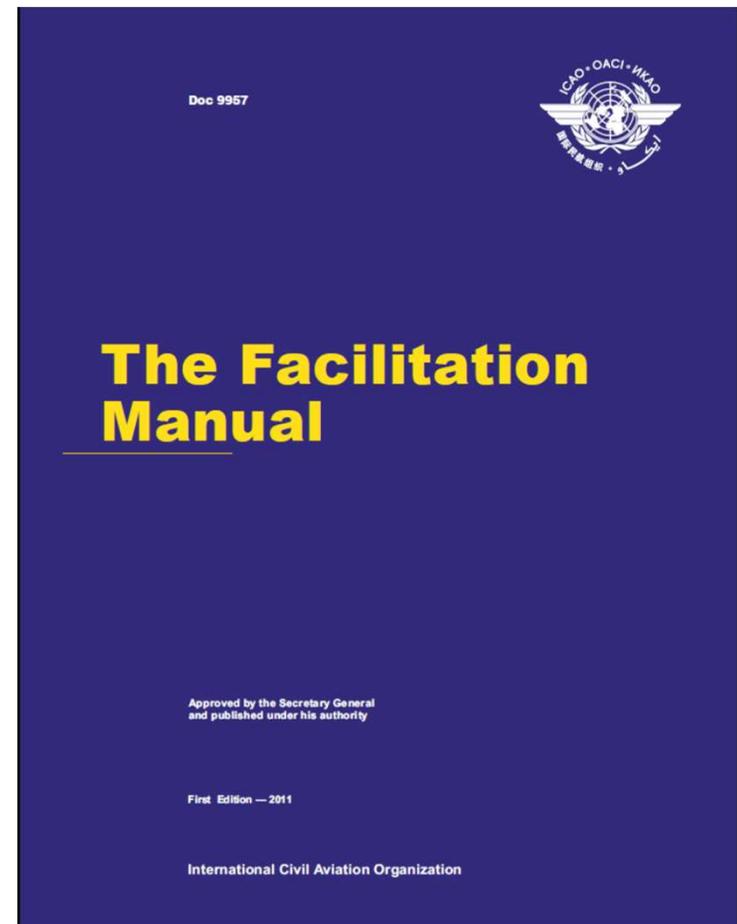

## ICAO Annex 9 - Facilitation

The ICAO Annex 9 – Facilitation is virtual classroom course that develops competencies relevant to staff from Civil Aviation Authorities (CAA) and border control authorities to deal collectively, in an inter-agency manner, with Annex 9's facilitation provisions.

### **Managing Air Transport Facilitation Course**

In progress, the development of Managing Air Transport Facilitation Training Course. The course provides the target audience with the competencies required to develop a management system whereby the Coordinating Authority (ies) designated by the State is (are) able to coordinate the required national policy framework, coordinate Facilitation matters with relevant government agencies and other stakeholders and to assess the implementation of Annex 9 SARPs and create a national evaluation framework



## Assistance to Aircraft Accident Victims and their Families

This course will provide CAA representatives, other government officials, aircraft and airport operators and non-governmental organization with the competencies to effectively support aircraft accident victims and their family assistance efforts, in accordance with ICAO Policy.



## Visible Digital Seals for Travel-Related Public Health Proofs

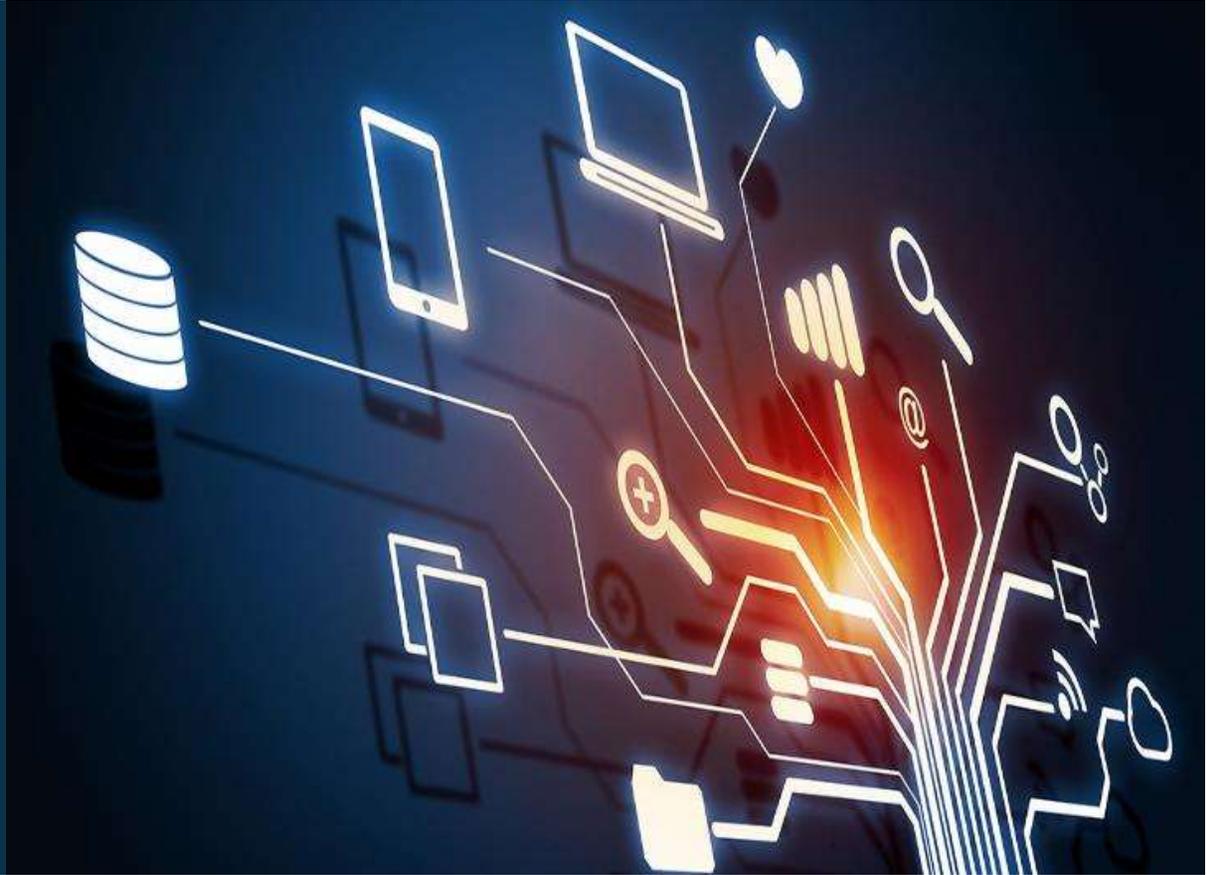
This course provides State authorities with the competencies required to implement a national Visible Digital Seal for Non-Constrained Environments (VDS-NC) solution for travel health proof, in accordance with ICAO Doc 9303, Machine Readable Travel Documents, Parts 9-13.



## Traveler Identification Programme (TRIP) Strategy

The course provides to the target audience the competencies to implement the five key elements of the ICAO TRIP strategy, ensuring interoperability and internal cooperation, in accordance with Annex 9.

## Amendments 27, 28 and 29 to Annex 9: Key developments in relation to TRIP

**Amdt 27: new and revised SARPs on Crew Identity Cards, the transport of minors by air and Passenger Data Exchange System.**

**Applicable: 21 February 2020**

**Amdt 28: new and revised SARPs on Passenger Name Record (PNR) data and ICAO Public Key Directory (PKD).**

**Applicable: 28 February 2021**

**Amdt 29: new and revised SARPs on Public Health Emergencies, Security of Travel and Health-proofs Documents and Passenger Name Record (PNR) Data.**

**Effective: 18 July 2022**

## Auditing of some PNR Standards under USAP-CMA

### AMENDMENT 28

6 New PNR Standards  
to be audited under the  
Universal Security Audit  
Programme



**Std 9.24:** Appropriate legal and administrative framework for the collection, use, processing and protection of PNR data.



**Std 9.25:** Identification of the PNR data to be used in State's operations, including the purposes for which PNR data may be used.



**Std 9.26:** Penalties for misuse, unauthorized access & unauthorized disclosure of PNR data, including mechanisms to prevent such acts.



**Std 9.28:** Automated processing of PNR data based on criteria that effectively indicate the existence of a risk, without leading to unlawful differentiation.



**Std 9.29:** Designation of entity(ies) responsible for the independent oversight of PNR data protection.



**Std 9.31:** Mechanisms related to the retention of PNR data.

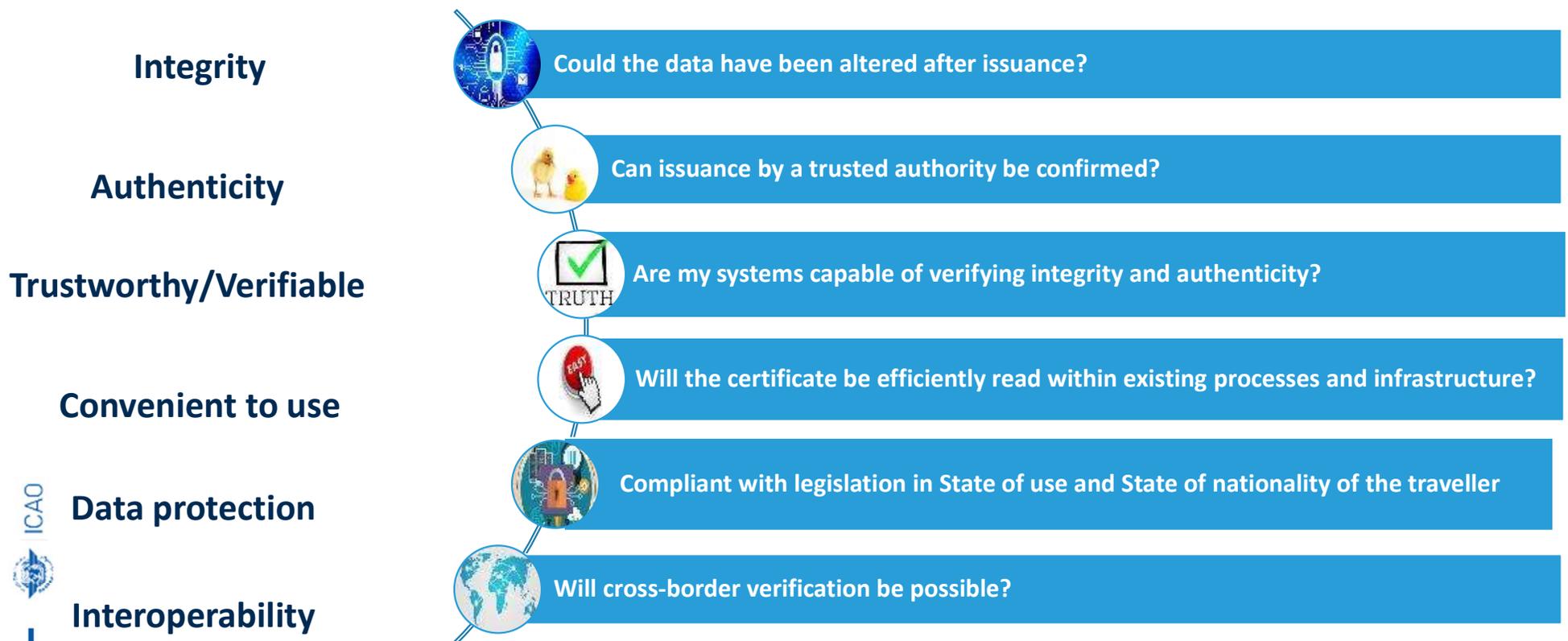

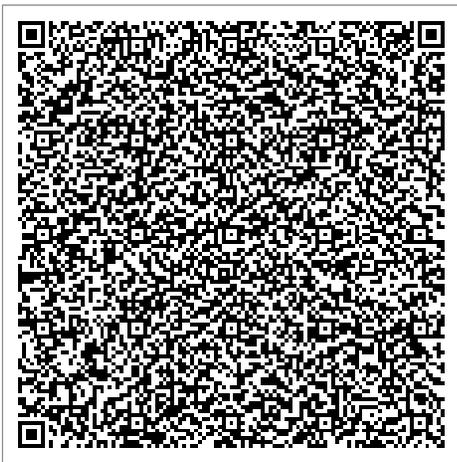

# Requirements for health proof certificates



## ICAO Visible Digital Seal for Non-Constrained Environments (VDS-NC)



- Encodes minimum dataset for tests, vaccinations and recovery certificates
- Machine readable using standard barcode scanners (e.g. at check-in, bag drop, boarding gates)
- Digitally signed (optional for testing certificates), using the same infrastructure as used by more than 145 States issuing ePassports

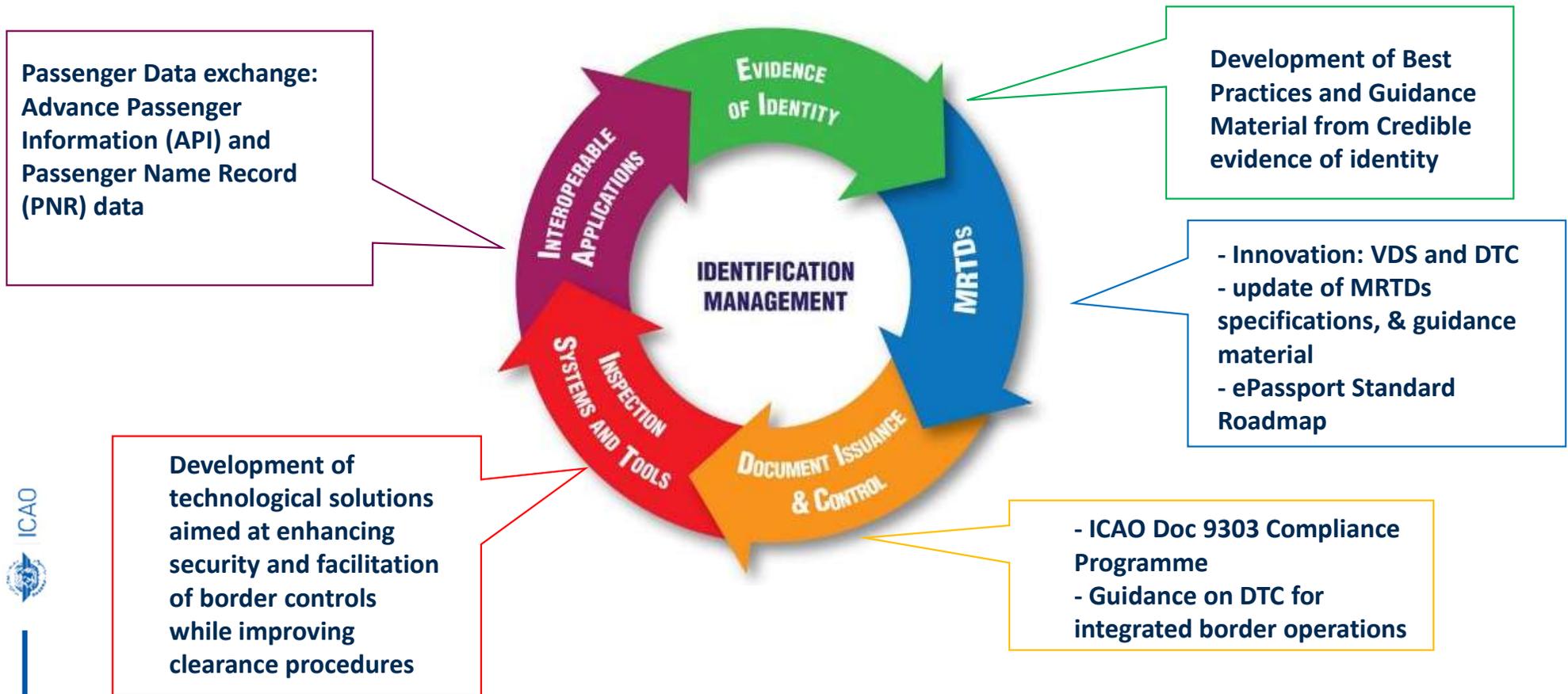

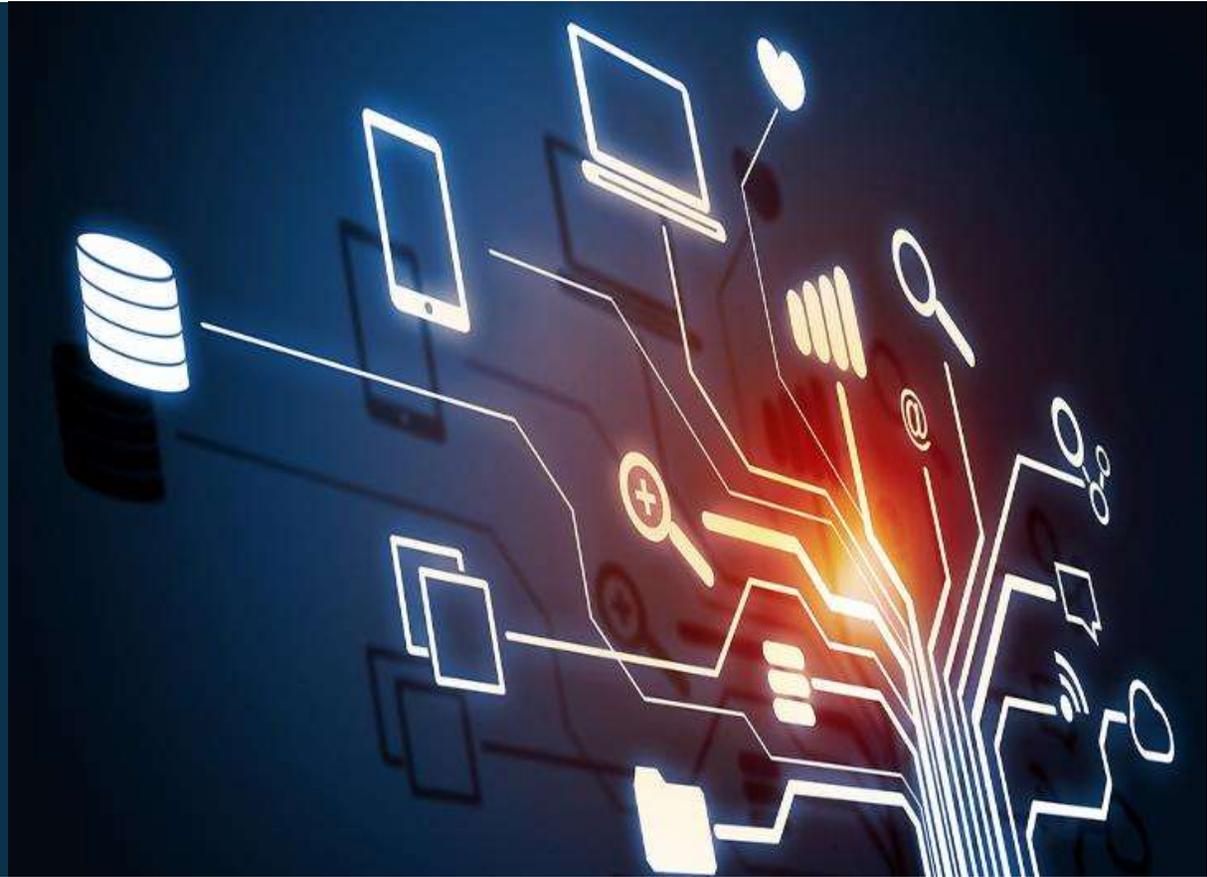

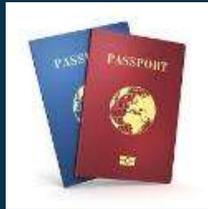

# Public Keys are Needed to Electronically Verify eMRTDs

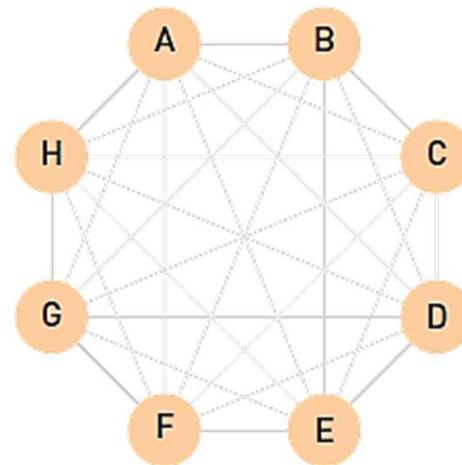


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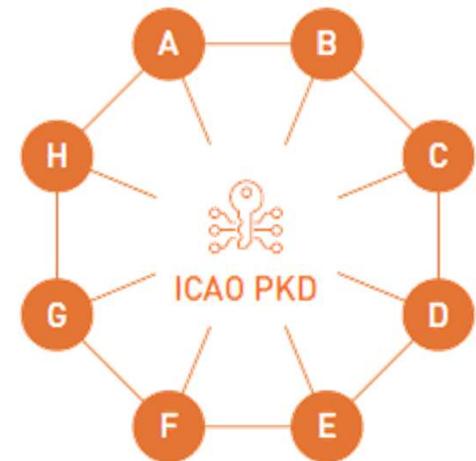


Verifying the cryptographic signature with the key verifies authenticity and integrity

The ICAO Public Key Directory (PKD) makes it easier to share public keys internationally

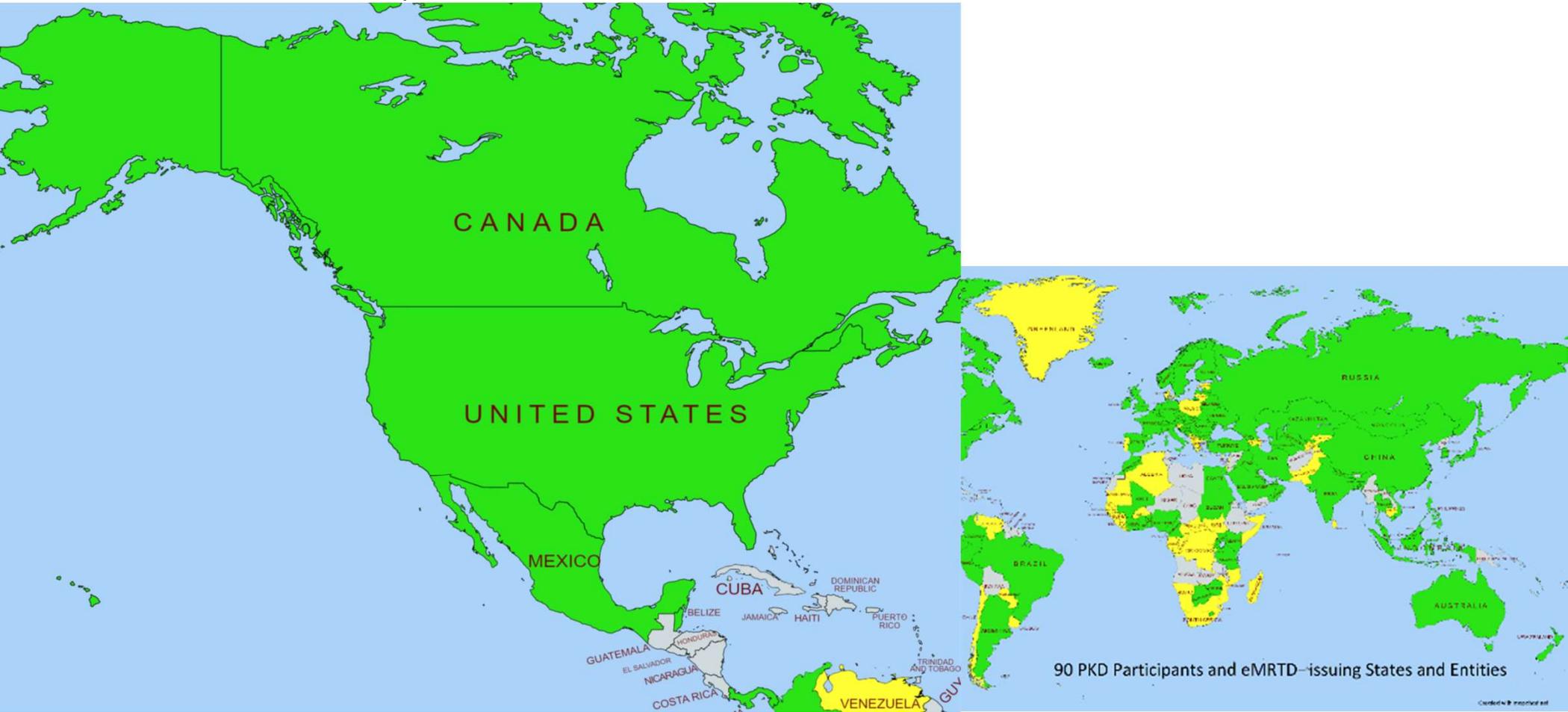


Without the PKD

## Regulatory Updates

Assembly Resolution A41-17 – Consolidated statement on continuing ICAO policies related to facilitation:

*“The Assembly...urges all Member States to join the ICAO PKD, upload relevant information from their own State to the PKD, and to use the information available from all States in the ICAO PKD to authenticate eMRTDs at border control”*

Annex 9 Standard 3.9.2 (Amendment 28):

*“Contracting States that participate in the ICAO PKD shall upload the public key data necessary for authentication of all electronic passports that they issue to the PKD.”*

More electronic documents – ePassport, DTC, VDS etc.



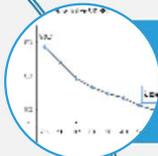
More demand for seamless/contactless travel

Updated content: A new Health Master List facilitating health proof verification globally



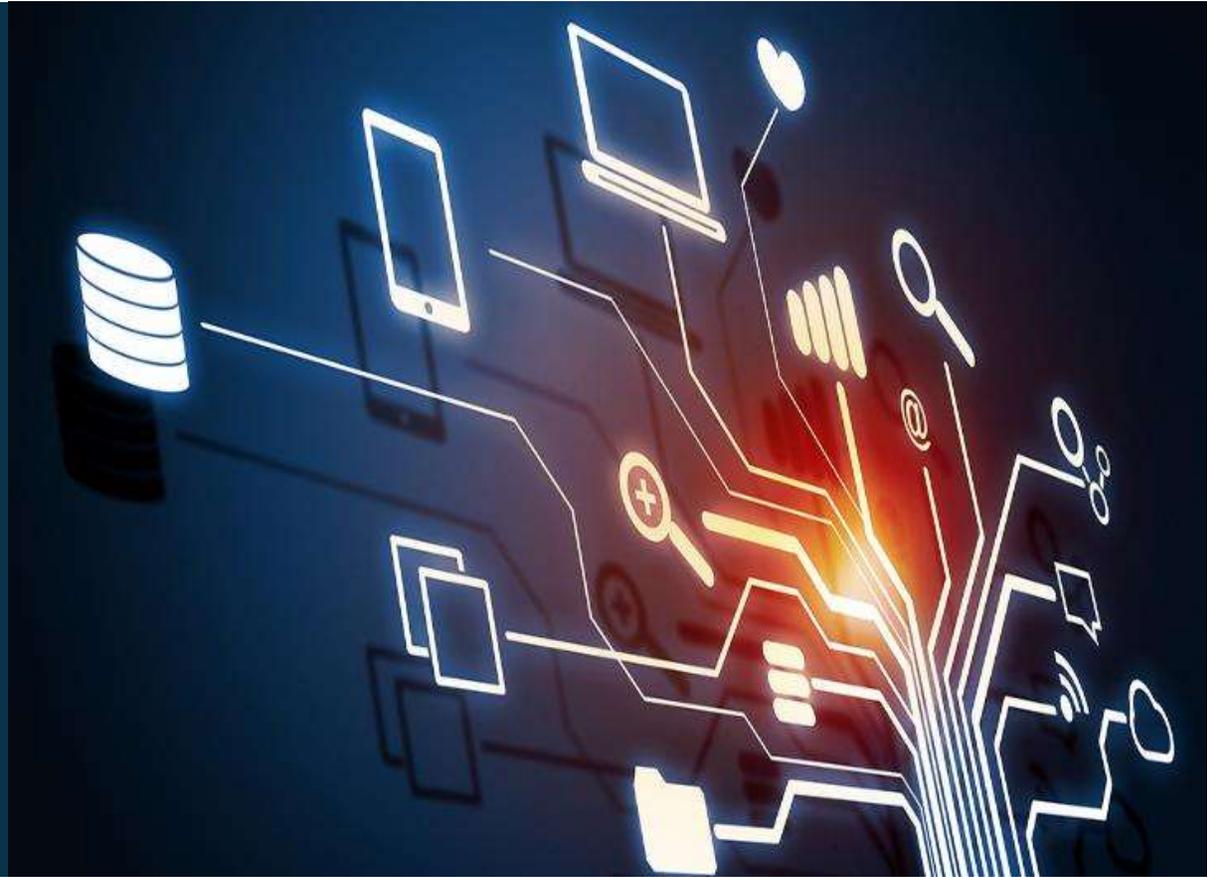
Capacity building: New Data Quality Coach – Mentoring from experienced States, funded by the PKD



Capacity building: Extended workshops and outreach amongst the community and from the community

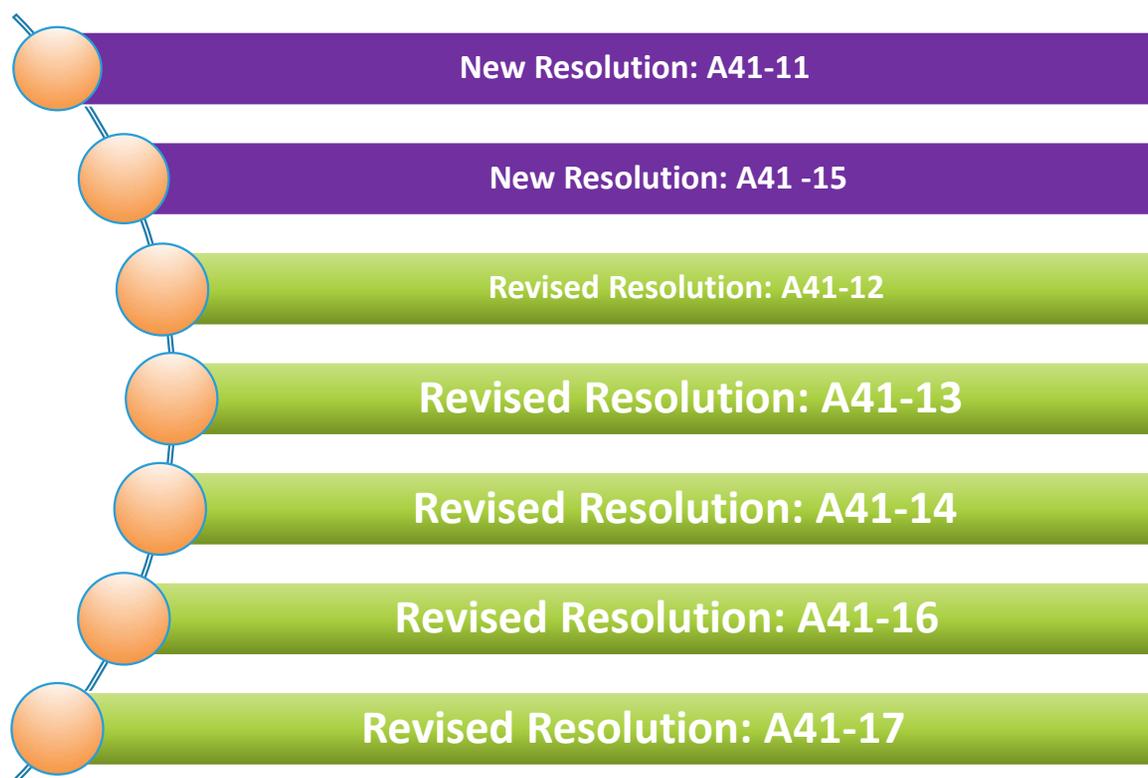
