SARPs Compliance (through audits)



Providing support to Member States in implementing ICAO provisions in an efficient and cost-effective manner





In collaboration with our recognized training centres around the globe, courses are delivered by qualified instructors and are available in self-paced or instructor-led formats, to provide wider accessibility


TRAINAIR PLUS Membership

Training Implementation, which refers to the training delivery of the ICAO training portfolio through the support of the TRAINAIR PLUS Network and its training partners






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Training Assessment Categories

Training Assessment Process

Pre- Assessment	Self- Assessment	On-site Assessment	Post Assessment
 Online application to the TRAINAIR PLUS Programme. Review and approval as a qualified candidate by the Global Aviation Training (GAT) Office. Coordinate a proposed schedule and timing for the on-site assessment. 	 Fill a self-assessment protocol questions (PQ) in the TPEMS, reviewing the scope of the onsite assessment. Answer each question and attach the evidence for reference. GAT assessor reviews all material and evidence submitted to prepare the onsite phase of the assessment process. 	 This phase consists on 3-4 day on-site assessment to the training centre conducted by an assessor of the GAT Office. GAT assessor visits the facilities in order to validate the self-assessment. Assessor will review each PQ and supporting evidence to determine outcomes (non-applicable, satisfactory, or non-satisfactory). 	 Follow-up of category one observations of the Corrective Action Plan (CAP), if any, and its implementation. The CAP and evidence of its implementation must be validated by the assessor, in cooperation with the training organization. Satisfactory implementation of the CAP leads to ICAO Assessment Report, and the granting of the TRAINAIR PLUS membership.

TRAINAIR PLUS Membership Plaque

- Upon the successful completion of the assessment and payment of the applicable fees, the applicant will be granted the TPP Bronze Associate membership status. A plaque will be issued, valid for a three-year period.
- Reassessments of TPP Members are conducted every three years to renew the membership for another period of three years.
- Reassessments allow ICAO to maintain an oversight on the quality and on TPP activities of the TPP Member, thus ensuring all Members continue to meet the established requirements.

STP (Standardized Training Package)	An STP is a competency-based training course developed by a TPP Member focusing on operational practices, using national regulations and procedures, and/or industry requirements. STPs are developed by the Course Development Unit (CDU) of a TPP Member under the supervision of an ICAO approved Instructional System Design (ISD) validator.	TPP MEMBER	METHODOLOGY
PTP (Partnership Training Package)	A PTP is a training or educational programme in aviation developed within the framework of a partnership agreement with a Corporate Partner or an industry partner.		CONTENT


















