


Issues or challenges faced by States




- Technical Personnel training

The responses were obtained from 16 States, the major incidences are the following:


TECHNICAL AREAS THAT NEED MORE SUPPORT




What are the needs or types of support from technical areas required by the States?



Within the Instruction needs of the areas, the most priority needs of the States are the following:



Most common problems found in technical personnel training:





Furthermore, other situations faced by the States that have other priorities were collected and are detailed below:

- Support at the highest level
- Development of regulatory framework and procedures
- Amendment and development of basic legislation
- Support in airport certification processes
- Support in the organization of the CAA

These topics will be addressed at a later stage, establishing priorities.

Proposed Solutions to the issues presented by the States:

1. On-Line Framework (OLF) / USOAP CMA Workshop: Initially the workshop will be conducted by ICAO Headquarters. Considering that not all the staff was able to attend the event, it is proposed to use the material from the workshop and with the enrichment of the experiences of the Regions to prepare the material for the workshop to be given at a State level within the Regions. It is planned that the improved workshop material will be finalized by May 2024 and can be delivered in person or virtually.





Proposed Solutions to the issues presented by the States:

2. The creation of a working group for the development of a regional training programme suitable and acceptable to ICAO. Through the States that volunteer to develop this document, work will be done in coordination with the ICAO NACC Regional Office virtually and the target for the completion of the regional training program is set for the first half of 2024.

Proposed Solutions to the issues presented by the States:

3. Personnel Needs Detection Methodology.

During the meeting, some criteria that should be used to improve the existing tools in the States for the detection of technical personnel needs will be presented and discussed. If necessary, an Ad-Hoc group will be formed to work on the subject in greater depth.



Proposed Solutions to the issues presented by the States:

4. The improvement and standardization of the use of regional training centers for the authorities is being evaluated, as well as the standardization of technical procedures for all areas.
