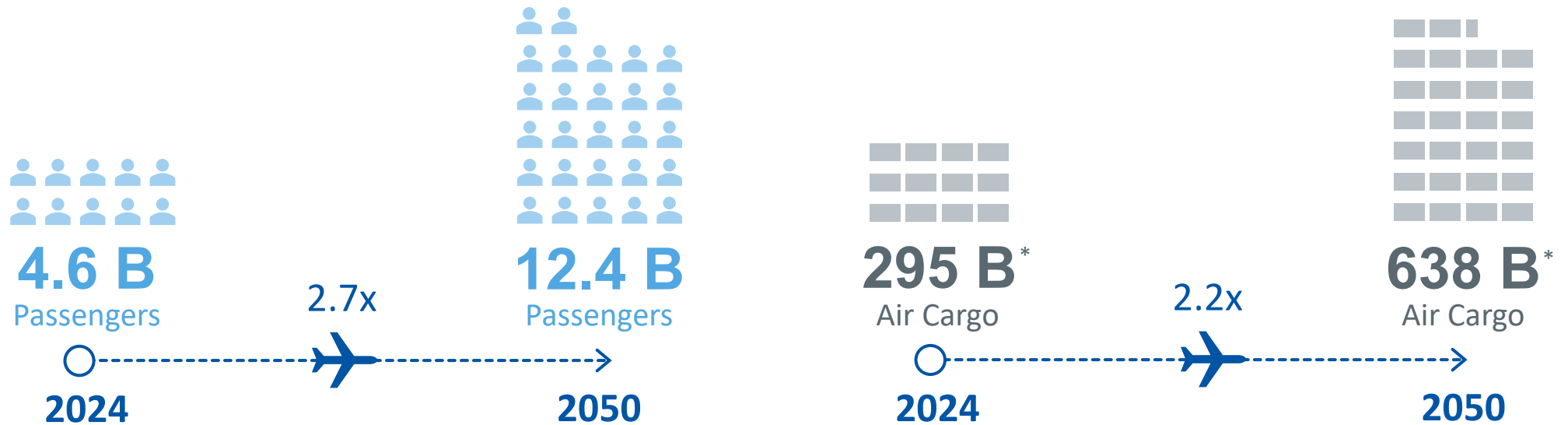


New ICAO long-term Strategic Plan 2026-2050

- Accessible language for non-aviation stakeholders

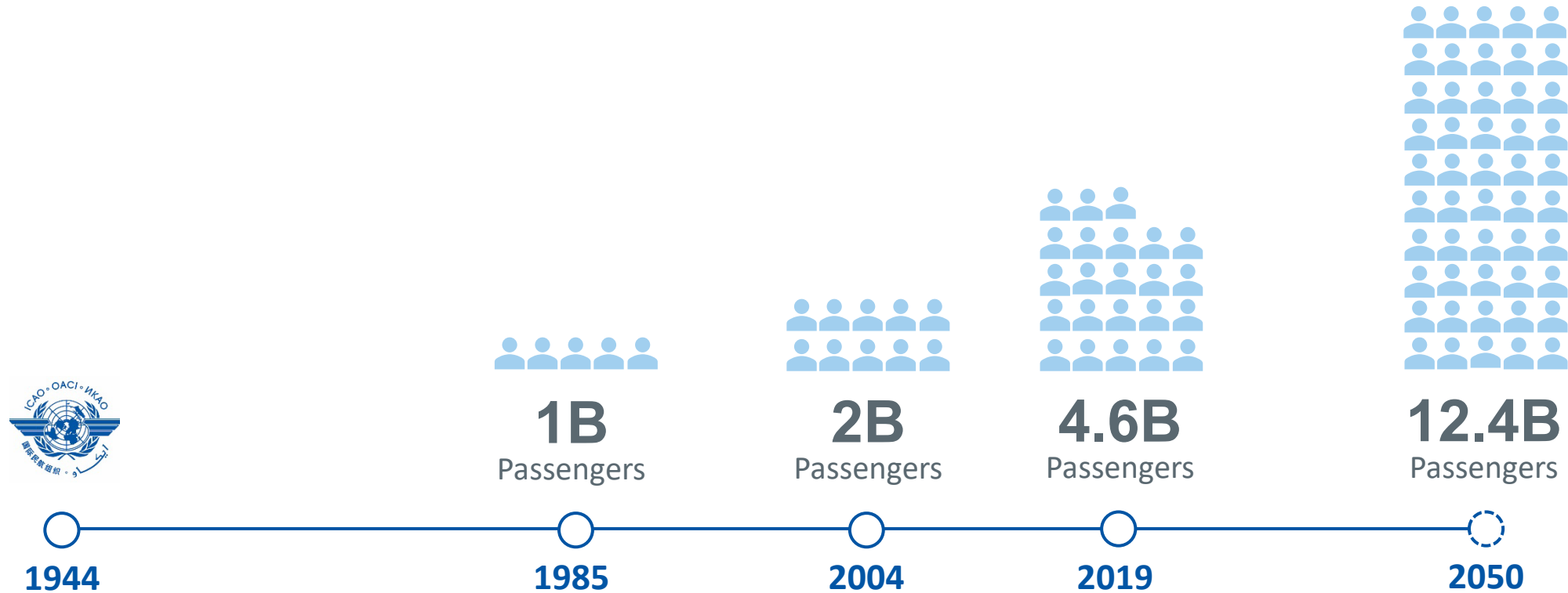


Passenger & Cargo increase

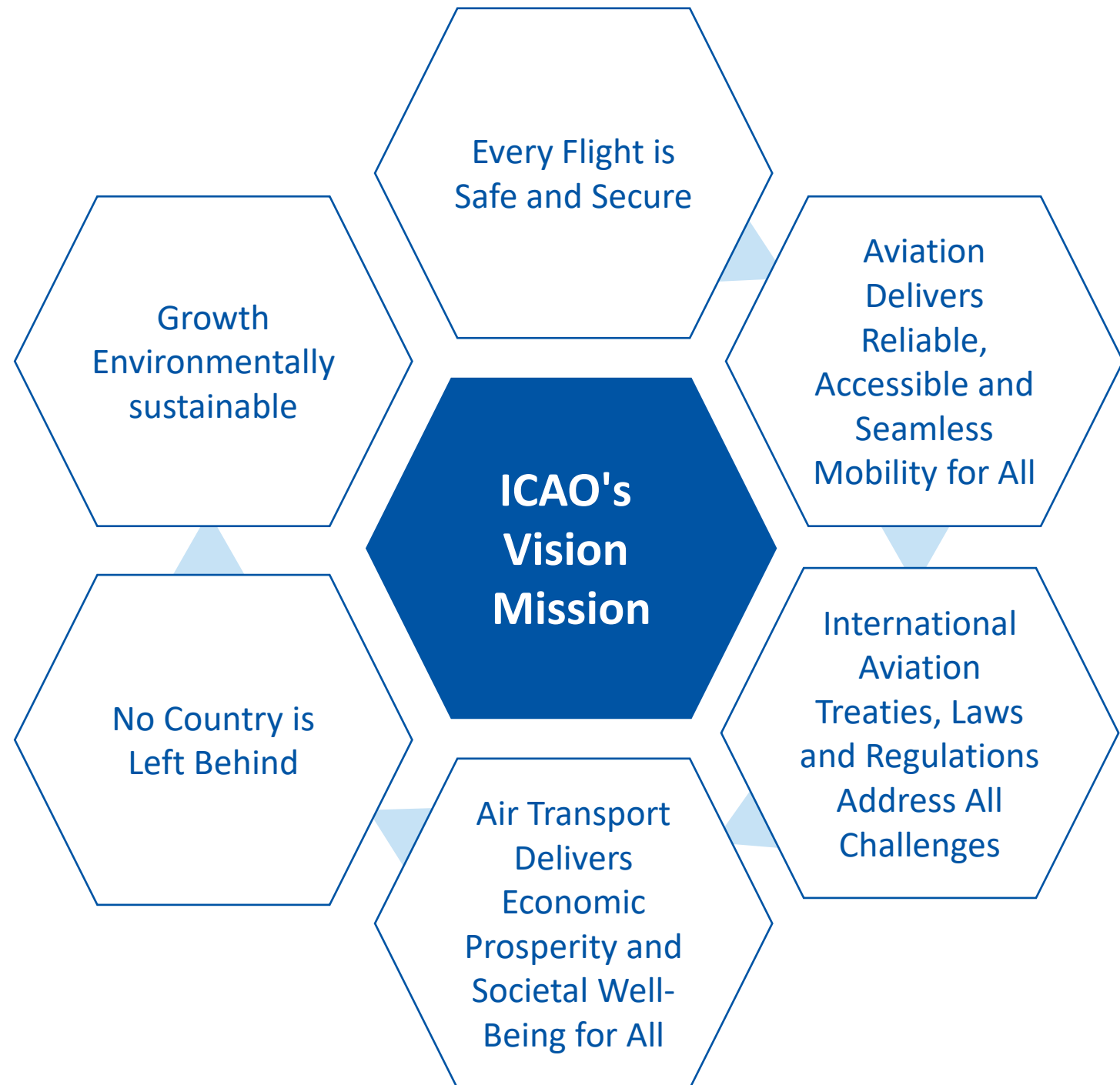

ICAO Mission

To lead international civil aviation as a key driver of social and economic development and environmental sustainability while enhancing aviation safety, security and economic development by advancing air law, developing policies, plans and standards, monitoring and auditing, and supporting States' capabilities for the benefit of all nations and people.
