## **AVSEC/FAL Training**

- ICAO AVSEC Training is delivered by ICAO AVSEC Instructors and based in Aviation Security Training Packages (ASTPs)
- Regular ICAO AVSEC Training is organized through the Aviation Security Training Centres (ASTC) network
- States and Territories can request specific ICAO AVSEC training in their locations through a formal letter to the NACC Regional Office
- All civil aviation stakeholders can benefit from the training, but organization and participants acceptance is managed only with the Civil Aviation Authority
- Possibility of online training for specific material (check table)
- Facilitation training coordinated with the ICAO NACC Regional Office and ICAO Headquarters

- Normally proposed and coordinated at the NAM, CAR and SAM AVSEC/FAL Regional Group
- support to specific initiatives of States and Territories
- Seminars, workshops and conferences on specific subjects (e.g. cybersecurity, aviation security screening equipment, USAP-CMA Protocol Questions interpretation)
- Original and tailored material by ICAO
- Collaboration of civil aviation stakeholders and international organizations
- Some event are organized by request of ICAO Headquarters or in support HQ initiatives





#### Joint Technical Assistance Missions


- Assist Member States in their endeavours to implement ICAO Annex 17 (Aviation Security) and ICAO Annex 9 (Facilitation) SARPs
- Two types of technical assistance missions depending on resources and duration:
  - **Overall Assessments**
  - Practical assistance: development of guidance material, risk assessment, joint oversight activities, etc.
- Coordination with the NACC Regional Office
- Cost sharing

## Support to Regional AVSEC/FAL Groups





- Two regional groups in the region:
  - Central-American Regional AVSEC Group
  - ECCAA National AVSEC Coordinators Group
- Development of regional guidance
- Joint position papers
- Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with third parties
- Coordination of oversight activities
- Coordination of sponsored training activities

#### Cooperation with other International Organizations

- Meetings on subjects related to AVSEC/FAL
- Participation in missions that contain an AVSEC/FAL component
- Under frameworks supported by Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs)
- Require formal request to the NACC Regional Office Director

















#### NAM, CAR and SAM ICAO/LACAC AVSEC/FAL Regional Group

Group established to improve coordination in AVSEC and FAL matters between the regions and to articulate cooperation mechanisms to avoid duplication of tasks. Its main objectives are:

- Support the AVSEC/FAL/RG Members in implementing Annex 17 and Annex 9 SARPs, among other international policies, resolutions and provisions related to such matters; and
- Align actions, processes and projects in the region related to AVSEC and FAL between States, international organizations, and industry.
