Objective: All Member States can

uniquely identify individuals

Globally interoperable applications that provide for timely, secure and reliable linkage of MRTDs and their holders to relevant data in the course of inspection operations, e.g. API, PNR, SLTD

EVIDENCE identification the and identification Management

Standard Communication Special Special

Credible evidence of identity, involving the tracing, linkage and verification of identity

Manufacture of standardized MRTDs, that comply with ICAO specifications (Doc 9303)

Processes for document issuance by appropriate authorities, and controls to prevent theft and loss

For the efficient and secure reading and verification of MRTDs, e.g. ABC, PKD

- ☐ The Fourth Meeting of the TAG/TRIP (TAG/TRIP/4)
 - Held from 11 to 13 October 2023 in Montréal
 - Endorsed amendments to technical specifications that will be incorporated in Doc 9303. And forwarded proposals for Amendment 30 to Annex 9, related to Borders
- **☐** Harmonization of the passport type indicator:

When Contracting States issue passports with a secondary document type indicator they shall be in accordance with the specifications of Doc 9303 no later than 1 January 2026

☐ Migration of biometrics data encoding:

Contracting States issuing eMRTDs shall update their facial image encoding by 1 January 2030 at the latest.

□ Enhancing data protection measures for eMRTDs:


Contracting States issuing eMRTDs shall implement Password Authenticated Connection Establishment (PACE) as of 1 January 2026.

UN Countering Terrorist Travel Programme

To assist Member States in building their capacities to prevent, detect, investigate and prosecute terrorist offences and other serious crimes, including their related travel, by collecting and analyzing passenger data, both API and PNR, in accordance with Security Council resolutions, ICAO Annex 9 standards and recommended practices, as well as other international law obligations.

Legal

 Legislative assistance to put in place a legal framework that regulates the collection, processing, retention, and protection of data

Operational

 Operational assistance to establish a Passenger Information Unit, including the delivery of training and drafting of standard operating procedures

Transport Industry Engagement

 Facilitating air carrier engagement and connectivity, by building close cooperation with the transport industry

Technical

 Providing technology support to deploy the UN 'goTravel' software to enable the collection, processing and analysis of passenger data










