

# Success in SAR Coordination

- Pilots well prepared
- ATC knew who to call (ARCC->MRCC)
- ATC informed to activate ELT
- ATC diverted Alaska Airlines to maintain communications
- MRCC Controller recognized significance of situation
- MRCC took initial actions
  - Issued broadcast
  - Launched C-130
  - Diverted Commercial ships



Challenges in SAR Coordination MRCC broadcast resulted in many units offering to divert

Hawaiian Airlines pressured SMC to assist

Heavy weather prevented timely rescue

Multiple family members called MRCC for updates
