**ROLES AND
RESPONSIBILITIES!**

Contracting States

- ➔ Defined as “***a State which has consented to be bound by the treaty, whether or not the treaty has entered into force***”.
- ➔ Each contracting State accepts to collaborate in securing the highest practicable degree of uniformity in:
 - ✈ *regulations, standards, procedures, and organization in relation to:*
 - aircraft,
 - personnel,
 - airways and
 - supporting services

In all matters in which such uniformity will facilitate and improve air navigation.

Contracting States

- ➔ Have usually **an established Civil Aviation Authority (CAA)** within their country as the regulatory body in the field of civil aviation.
- ➔ The CAAs primarily deal with safety issues and are **responsible for the regulations** of air transport services to/from/within the country, and for **the enforcement** of civil air regulations, air safety and airworthiness standards.
- ➔ The CAAs **manage all regulatory functions** by taking the policy decisions required by the advances made in the field of International Standards and Recommended Practices (**SARPS**) adopted in the **ICAO Annexes**.

Contracting States

- ✈ The CAAs are headed by the Director General of Civil Aviation (**DGCA**).
- ✈ ICAO communicates with its Contracting States through the DGCA by the means of **States Letters** and **Electronic Bulletins** (For information only).
- ✈ DGCA and their experts participate in ICAO meetings and follow-up action thereon.
- ✈ At ICAO, DGCA meet for high-level discussions or strategies in the field of aviation either during Assembly Sessions or subject-dedicated conferences (like the NACCDCA).

NACC WG AIM TF Rapporteur

- ✈ A person appointed/elected by the NACC State Members and ICAO NACC, for minimal 3 years
- ✈ Leads AIM TF Meetings and Reports on the proceedings of the AIM TF meetings.
- ✈ Keeps close contact, reports to and collaborates with the Regional Officer. AIM
- ✈ Manages the TF and collaborates with the AIM TF Members.
- ✈ Provides guidance, trainings and assistance there where needed, related to the AIM TF Action Plan and Activities (Work Programme, Terms of Reference).



Role & Responsibilities

State Members – Rapporteur - Activities

NACC WG AIM TF Rapporteur

- ✈ Must obtain as much information as possible on a specific subjects and must inform the TF about the findings.
- ✈ Analyzes ongoing projects (AIS to AIM transition, SWIM, IM, New NOTAM Concept/DORIS etc.).
- ✈ Consults with other specialists within the AIM.
- ✈ Discusses issues, on going progresses on specific projects and States' necessities for Regional implementation.
- ✈ Produces TF decisions and recommendations Reports made with TF members.

AIM TF Main Activities for Members

- ✈ Participate **Actively** in meetings/teleconferences called by the AIM Rapporteur:
- ✈ *Provide documentations for meeting of the AIM TF to the AIM Rapporteur*

- ✈ *Give presentations*
- ✈ *Brainstorm*

Goal:

- ✈ To **pinpoint** the specific steps, tasks and resources vital for AIMs Regional developments.
- ✈ To have a reasonable **timeline and planning program** for the TF, to realize the activities and plans

Action Plan AIM TF

Within the NACC WG AIM TF

- ➔ **Objective:** to have a more efficient approach to carrying out the assigned tasks within the TF.
- ➔ To execute required actions on the Action Plan, the AIM TF must keep maintain a realistic time-line in perspective and “No Country Left” behind concept.
- ➔ States must also keep track of the Action Plan, and request guidance, assistance on time to ICAO for proper execution. Reporting to the Rapporteur is vital.
