Further to my *Save the date* letter ref. E.OSG-NACC115497 dated 7 April 2025, I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the Thirteenth North American, Central American and Caribbean Directors of Civil Aviation Meeting (NACC/DCA/13) to be convened at the Sheraton Hotel, in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, from 4 to 7 August 2025 which will be kindly hosted by the Instituto Dominicano de Aviación Civil (IDAC) of Dominican Republic. Please note the change of dates to the current ones of 4 to 7 August 2025.

Considering the importance of strategic planning with ICAO's new Long-Term Plan and discussions at the upcoming 42nd ICAO Assembly, an ICAO Workshop on *Civil Aviation Master Planning (CAMP): An Overview for Director Generals of Civil Aviation* is proposed on 4 August 2025 as a preamble to the agenda of the NACC/DCA/13 meeting, of which a concept note is attached for ease of reference.

In support to States to align and works towards the aviation goals contained in the new ICAO Strategic Plan 2026-2050, the meeting will seek to introduce Director Generals into strategic planning matters- Directors General of Civil Aviation Authorities of States and Territories of the ICAO NAM/CAR Regions, and representatives of invited international organizations are expected to attend. The working languages of the meeting will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided if sufficient participants of both languages provide timely registration.

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If you wish to share information on key programmes and activities at the meeting, you are encouraged to rely less on Working Papers than in previous meetings. Instead, where participants wish to share information with the meeting, they are highly encouraged to submit, short, concise, and dynamic presentations, with Information Papers containing the bulk of the detail as a reference to participants. Working Papers must have an action, or they will be considered an information paper. "Take note of the information in the paper" is not an action, and Working Papers submitted with only this action will be considered Information Papers.

The Draft Agenda and schedule of the event is at **Appendix A**. Explanatory Notes will be included in WP/01. States wishing to submit proposals for the addition of items should do so by **30 June 2025**.

Working papers should be brief, action-oriented, and focused with a four-page limit excluding any appendices.

Working Papers must be submitted in both languages, English and Spanish. Information Papers will be published only in the language(s) presented. The deadline to receive documentation is 21 July 2025_and no materials will be accepted after this date.

Moreover, the Twelfth Meeting of the RLA09801 Multi-Regional Civil Aviation Assistance Programme (MCAAP) Project Steering Committee (RLA09801 PSC/12) will be held in a separate session within the same period and in the same premises of the NACC/DCA/13 meeting. In this regard, I am pleased to inform that each MCAAP Focal Point¹ of RLA09801 Project Members that is upto-date with its Project contributions may apply for a one-day event subsidy to attend the RLA09801/PSC/12. A specific invitation for the RLA09801/PSC/12 will be submitted shortly. The event subsidy includes Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) to cover lodging and per diem. Your Administration shall provide the candidate with the air ticket to/from Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, and ensure that the candidate has the necessary travel documents, vaccinations, and visa prior to departure. The duly completed Event Subsidy Nomination Form must be received in this Regional Office by **3 June 2025**.
