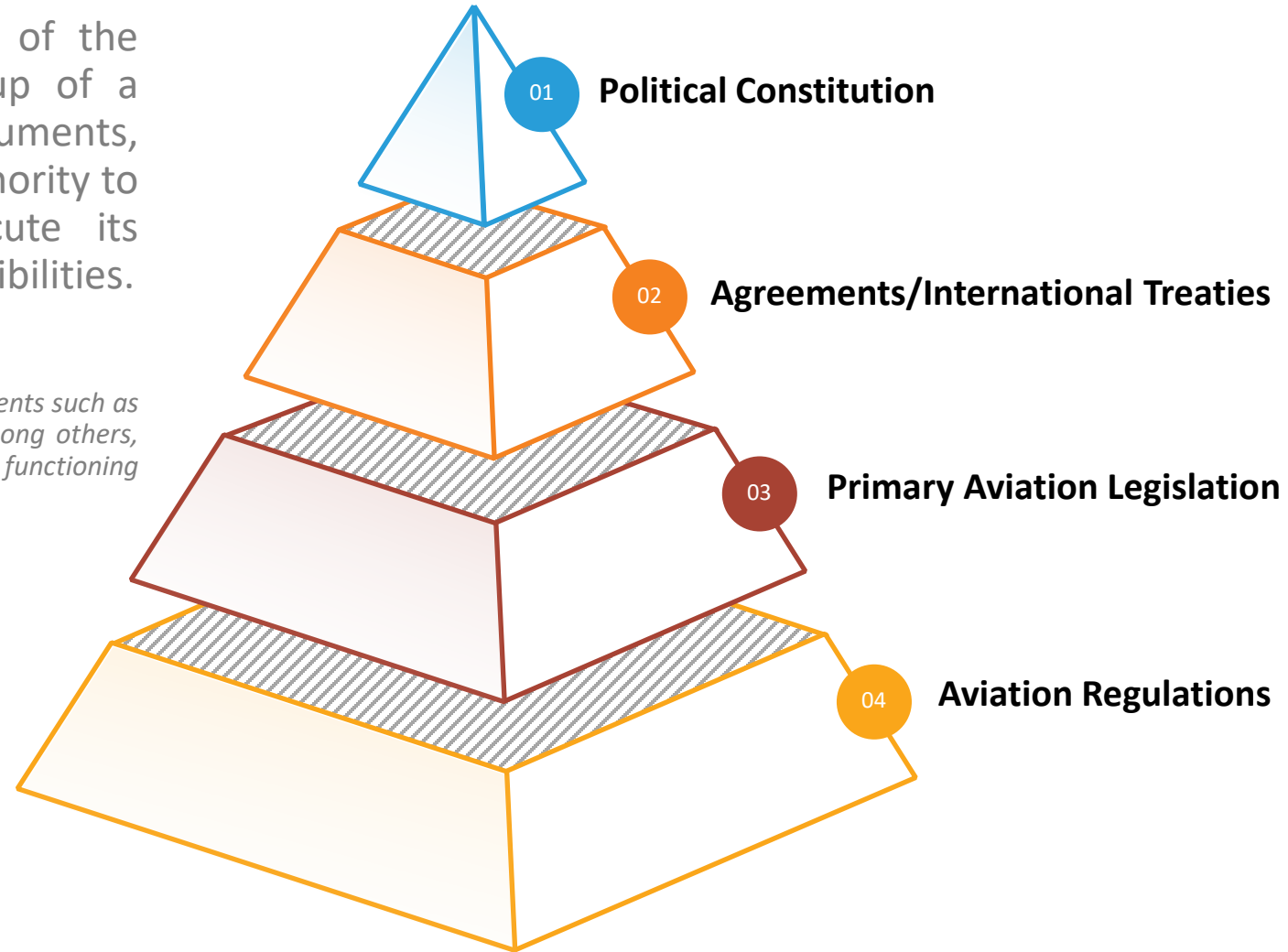


# CAA Legal Framework



The legal framework of the CAA can be made up of a variety of legal instruments, which enable the Authority to carry out and execute its functions and responsibilities.

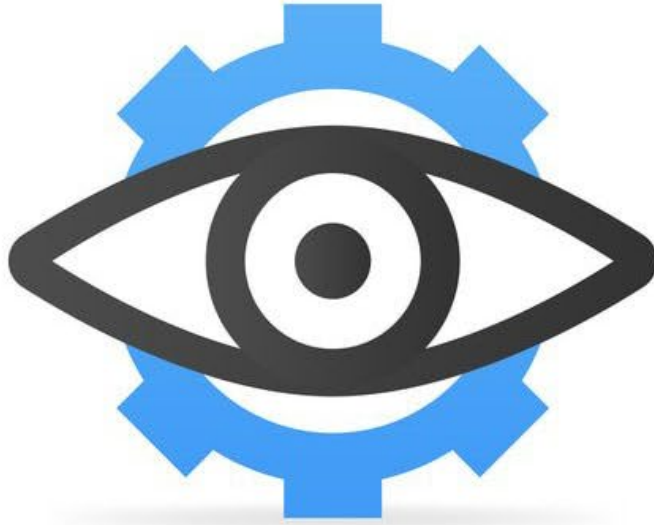
*There may also be other instruments such as decrees, policies, guidelines, among others, that can have an impact on the functioning of the AAC.*

# MISSION, VISION AND QUALITY POLICY

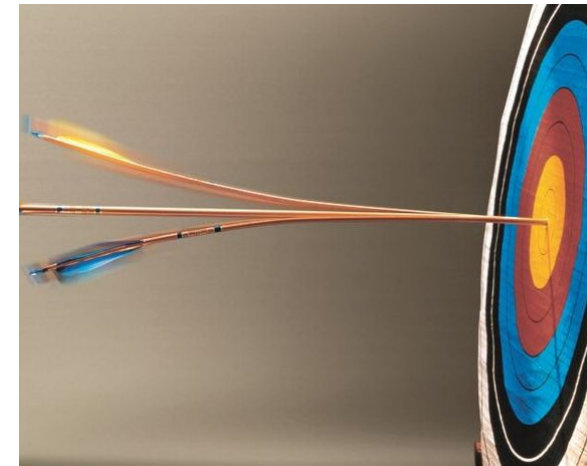
# Mission

Who are the people in charge?

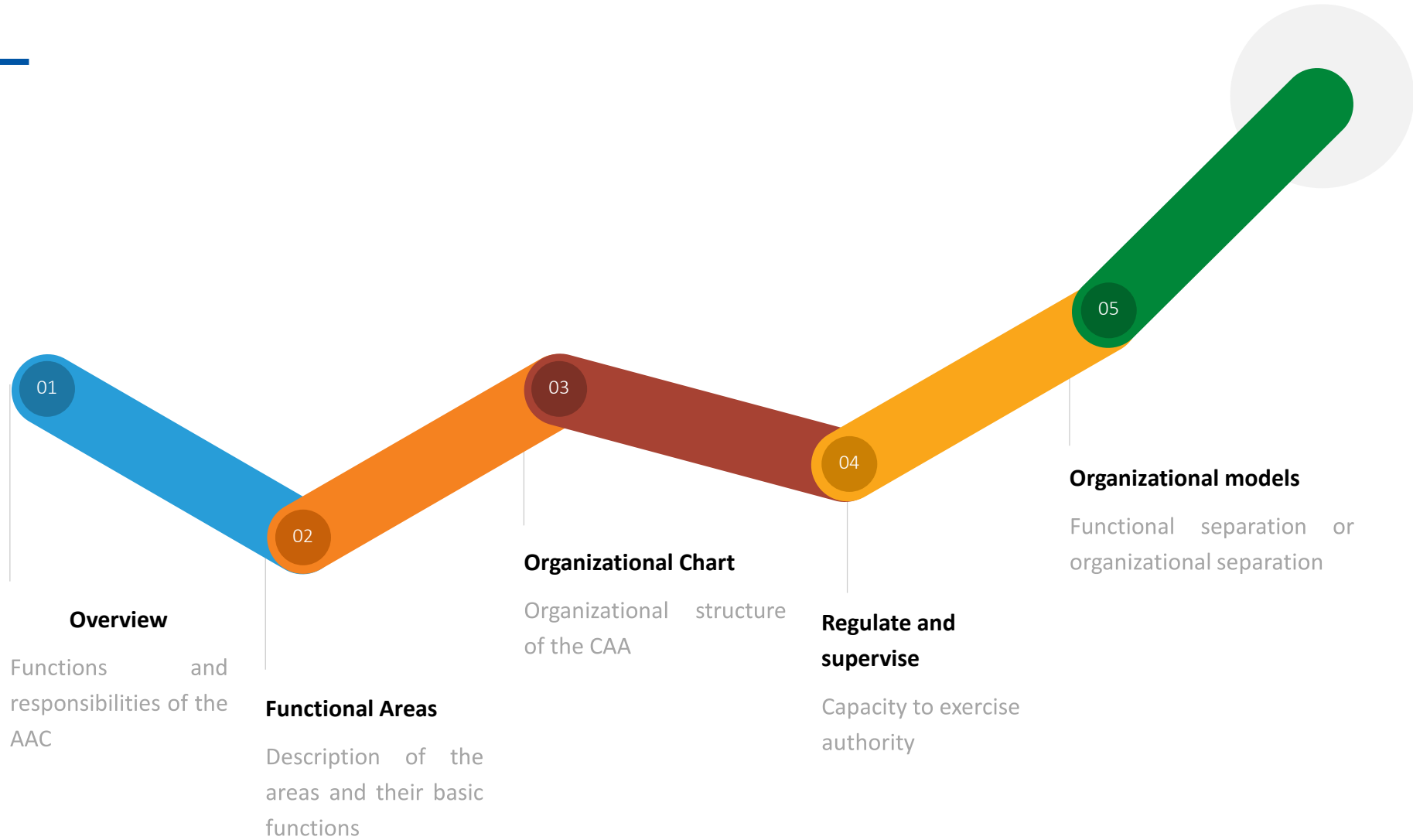


Based on what objectives are the functions performed?



# FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CAA





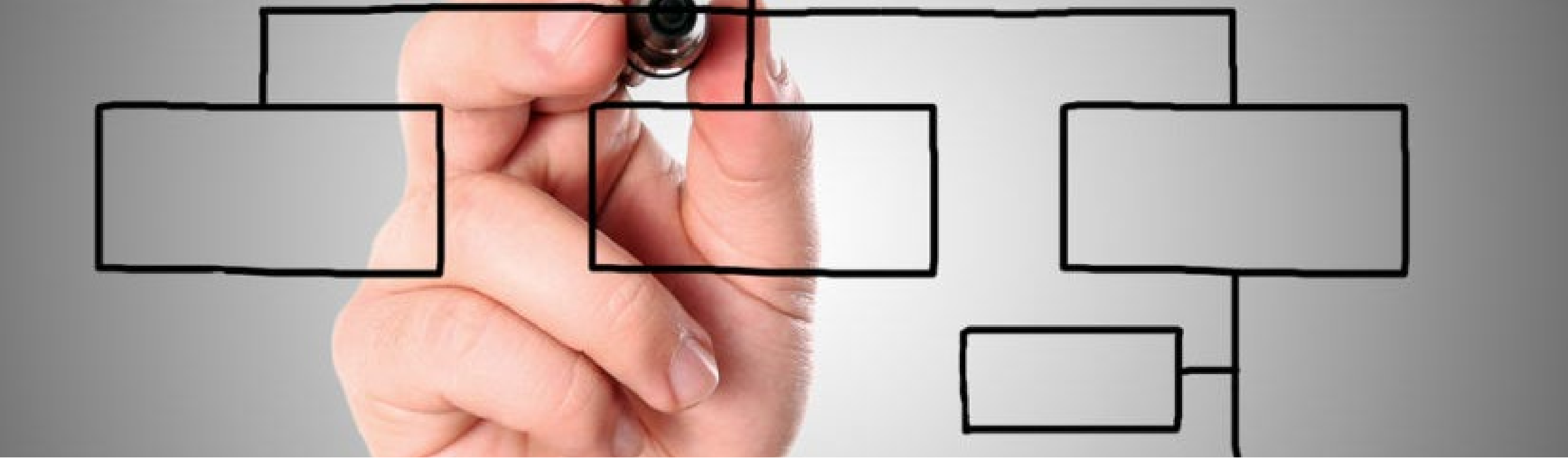


# FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ANS SURVEILLANCE AREA

- The administrative functions required to fulfill safety oversight tasks should be considered.

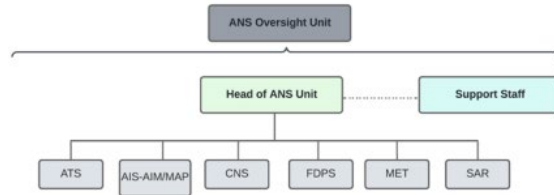
*These roles and responsibilities may be described in other CAA documents, so in these cases, these documents can be referenced to maintain consistency and uniformity.*



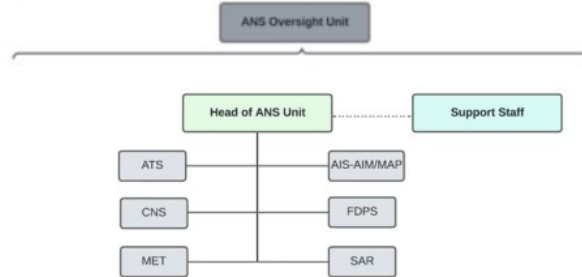


# ORGANIZATIONAL CHART FOR THE ANS OVERSIGHT AREA

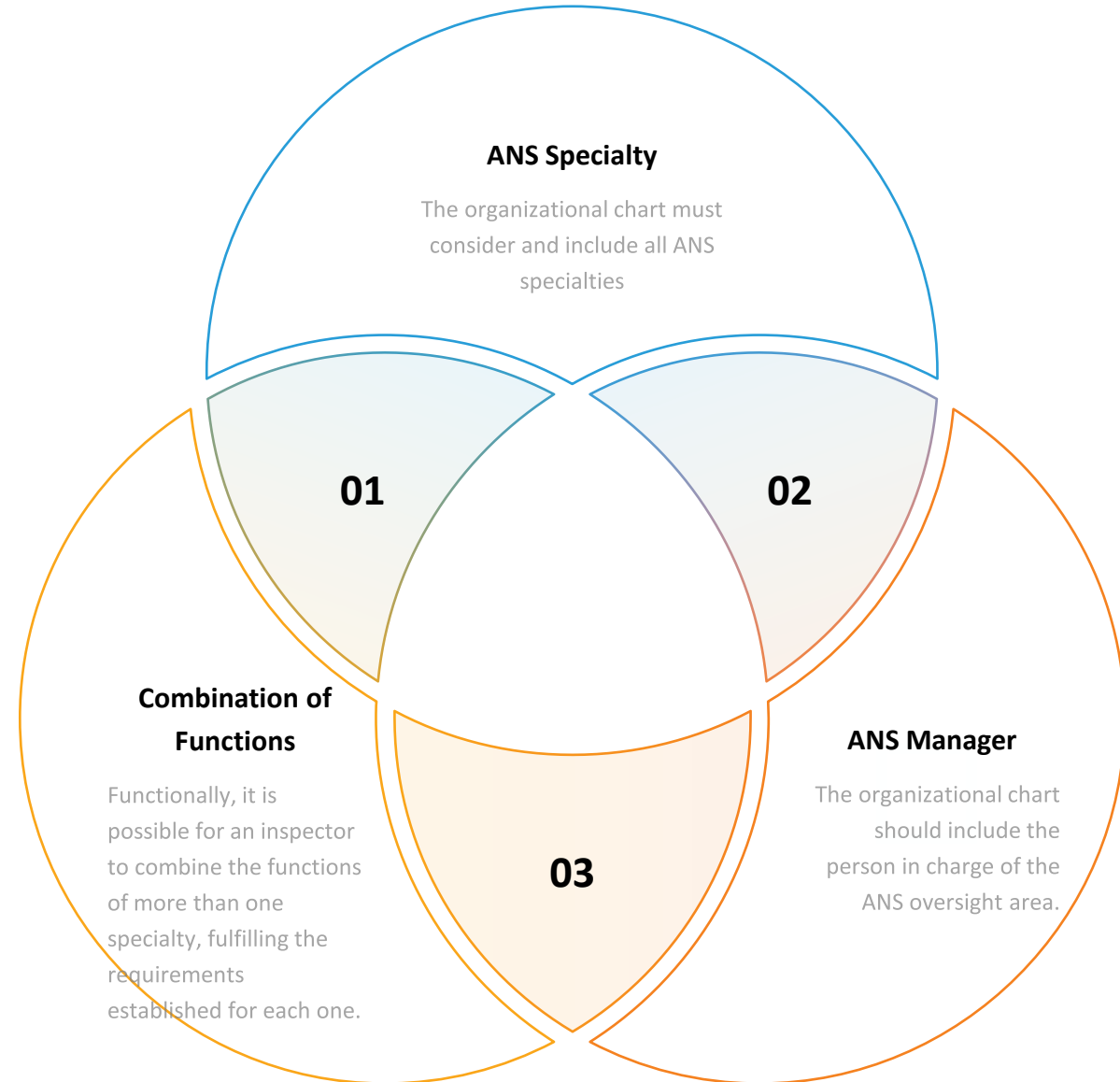
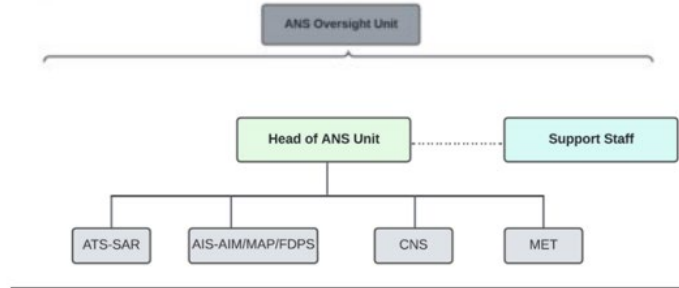
