As part of the updated strategy for the State Safety Programme (SSP) presented to the Tenth North American, Central American and Caribbean Directors of Civil Aviation Meeting (NACC/DCA/10), and as a follow-up to the support provided by Regional Aviation Safety Group—Pan America (RASG-PA) in order to foster the implementation of the SSP in the CAR Region, I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the Fifth State Safety Programme (SSP) Working Group Meeting for the NAM/CAR Regions (NAM/CAR/SSP/WG/5) to be convened from **27 to 29 May 2024** at the ICAO NACC Regional Office, Mexico City, Mexico.

Following the SSP/WG Terms of Reference (ToRs) the review of the status of the SSP implementation in the NAM/CAR Regions will be presented in the SSP/WG/5 Meeting, among the main discussion items. The Meeting is aimed at defining the upcoming activities of the working group and the assistance to the States concerning SSP implementation (SSP Work Programme), taking into account the new GASP and participation in the update of the current RASP. Two main topics for discussion are a) analysis of mechanisms to support implementation: projects, initiatives, workshops, etc.; and b) the definition of the means to monitor and report on this implementation, for which we will seek to exchange ideas to define relevant regional indicators and metrics.

SSP Points of Contact (PoCs) of the NAM/CAR Regions States and Territories are expected to participate, as well as Regional Safety Oversight Organization (RSOO) representatives of the CAR Region. The working languages of the Meeting will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided if sufficient participants of both languages provide timely registration
