- 4.2 Costa Rica will talk with COCESNA, in order to report their progress in the ARESAC project

- 4.3 Cuba reported that during the next month will be signing the LoA with the Merida FIR in order to reduce to 20 NM; with the Kingston FIR commented they have a harmonized separation within their infrastructure; with United States have work very closely to expand routes and guarantee effective traffic flow, and in this regard a PfA will be prepared for next year, 5 February 2017, approximately.

- 4.5 United States commented to have good will towards working together with other FIRs and to focus on harmonization and modernization. Will held separate telcons with ICAO in September.
