6. **Temperature**

Santiago is located in the central area of Chile and has a Mediterranean climate. In this part of the territory, weather conditions are more moderate, combining a considerable amount of rainfall with a wider distribution of the same. The rains tend to concentrate mainly in the winter months. The climate is dry and temperate in summer. In all the cities in this area, the seasons are distinct during the whole year, the cold season is from May to September and the warmest since October to April. In the coastal zone, the variations are smoother. In Santiago, Los Andes and Rancagua cities, temperatures vary significantly in winter, with an average of 8° C, while in summer is 20° C, although it can reach on up to 32 ° C.

The minimum temperature average for the month of October is 9 $^{\circ}$ C and the maximum temperature is 27 $^{\circ}$ C, however according to the situation of the day; the wind chill at night may be two to three degrees below room temperature.

7. Money exchange

The national currency is the Peso Chileno. Current exchange rate is 605 Pesos Chilenos per US\$ 1.00, approximately. Money exchange has to be made at Banks or authorized Currency Exchange Offices.


8. Credit Cards

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10. Transportation from/to the airport

19. General recommendations in the event of an earthquake

During an earthquake

a) Keep calm.

- b) Stay away from windows, do not go to any balconies, and do not use elevators.
- c) Locate yourself in previously identified internal safety zones.
- d) Evacuate the premises only if conditions permit it; otherwise, minimize your movements.
- e) Follow the instructions given in these cases.

After an earthquake

- f) Proceed to leave the premises, since quakes can continue.
- g) Evacuation must be carried out calmly, quickly and safely through the indicated routes.
- h) Stay in the evacuation site until the designated security team of the building has verified whether the installations are at risk.
