**SUMMARY**

This Working Paper presents the progress on the Conclusion 2/10 from the ICAO/LACAC NAM/CAR/SAM Second Meeting of the Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group, (AVSEC/FAL/RG/2) regarding the development of a Regional Aviation Security Training Events Database (AVSECTAD) and its implementation.

## 1. Introduction

1.1 During the ICAO/LACAC NAM/CAR/SAM Second Meeting of the Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group, (AVSEC/FAL/RG/2) held in Antigua and Barbuda, from 16 to 18 de May 2012, the Secretariat proposed a coordination mechanism development for the training activities conducted by different States and Organizations in the Region, as aviation security assistance addressed to the States in order to reduce effort duplication. The Meeting concluded that a restricted database would be developed to share the training activities in the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions, using as a template the Implementation Support and Development Assistance List (ISDAL) database used by the ICAO Ad hoc Group for the cooperation on AVSEC capacity development. The Meeting agreed that the Secretariat develop the proposed structure and an information sharing mechanism.

1.2 The Meeting agreed on the Conclusion 2/10 - *Coordination between States and Organizations providing AVSEC Training Assistance*, providing the responsibility for this project to the Secretariat.

## 2. Update on the Regional AVSEC Training Events Database progress

2.1 The Secretariat developed the Regional Aviation Security Training Events Database (AVSECTAD) for the exchange of information on the Regional AVSEC Training assistance to the States/Territories providers and recipients, and through the State Letter (EMX0776/SA551) issued by the ICAO/LACAC Secretariat on 12 September 2012, circulated for review and comments. The comments received were generally positive, and after some coordination, the project was completed by the end of April 2013, with later adjustments.

2.2 Finally, through the State Letter (EMX0426/SA275) dated on 23 May 2013, the ICAO/LACAC Secretariat requested the States to designate a Point-of-Contact to access the Database.

2.3 The States/Territories that replied the Point-of-Contact request were:

2.4           Contacts designated by their States/Territories appropriate AVSEC Authorities, will access to the Database after registering themselves in the AVSECTAD and receive a password by e-mail. A Registration Guide was sent individually to the points of contact for ease of reference on the registration process.

### **3.               Suggested Action**

3.1           States are urged to designate their AVSECTAD representatives, if they have not done yet, in order to obtain benefit from the future Regional AVSEC training events and the possible complementary awarding of fellowships provided by donor States/Organizations.
