# Corporate Structure



## Sales:

- ▶ In 2010, the Bundesdruckerei Group generated sales of around EUR 351 million
- ▶ ID documents and systems accounted for approximately 80 % of turnover

## Production 2010:

- ▶ 10.8 million ID Cards
- ▶ 6.4 million Passports
- ▶ 3.5 million EU Driving Licences

## Customers & Services:

- ▶ The Bundesdruckerei reference project for the Federal Republic of Germany and its 82 million citizens includes around 6,850 registration offices equipped with over 20,000 data acquisition workstations. The Bundesdruckerei is responsible for the complete roll-out and maintenance of the infrastructure for the digital application systems installed.



# The German ID Card – One Year On

- ▶ Roll out of production and personalisation in Berlin – started 1st November 2010
- ▶ To date over 7 million ID Cards have been issued
- ▶ Optical and electronic identification is possible with the ID card
- ▶ Implementation of enrolment and issuance hardware and software including service and support to over 6,500 offices country wide



- ▶ Fully integrated and scalable solution for card production at one facility
- ▶ Real continuous just-in-time production with highest throughput and yield



- ▶ New production facility – moving from ID2 to ID1 format
- ▶ Continuing the security concept of personalisation in the card body
- ▶ In-line production of materials from web, sheet and roll

# Introduction of the New eResidence Permit


- ▶ Rolled out from 1st September 2011




