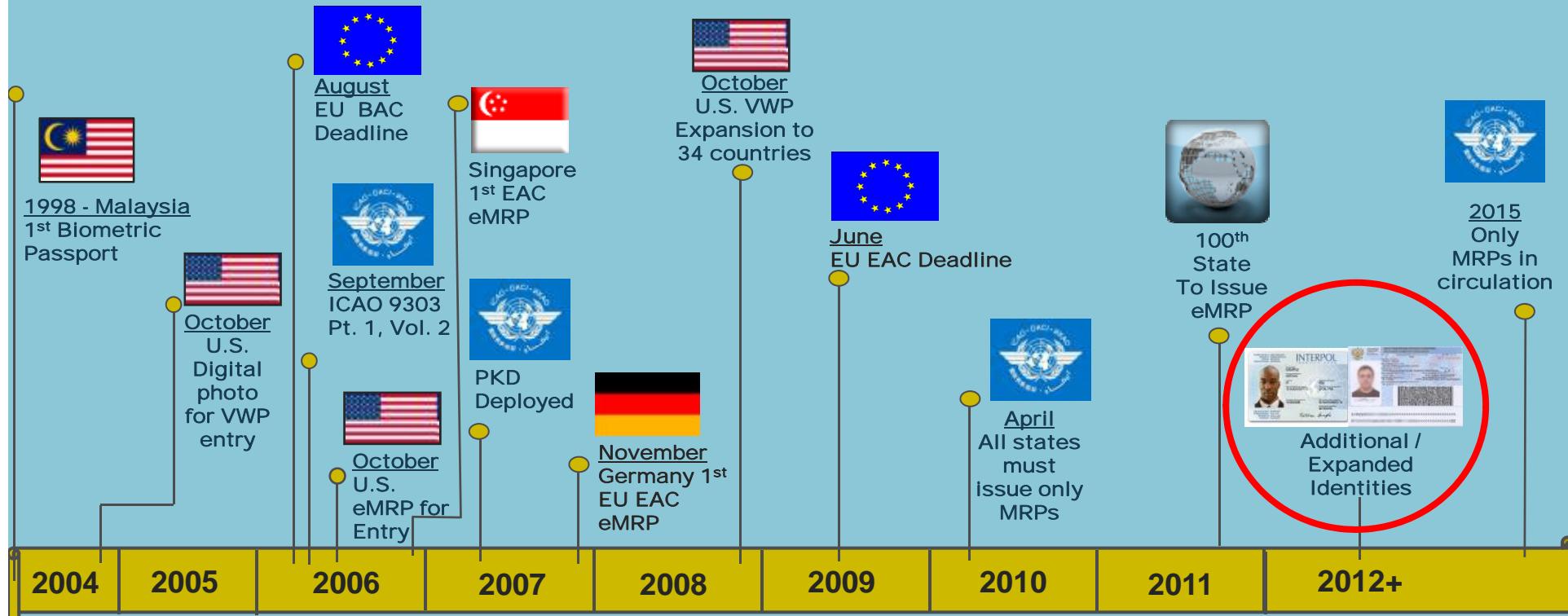

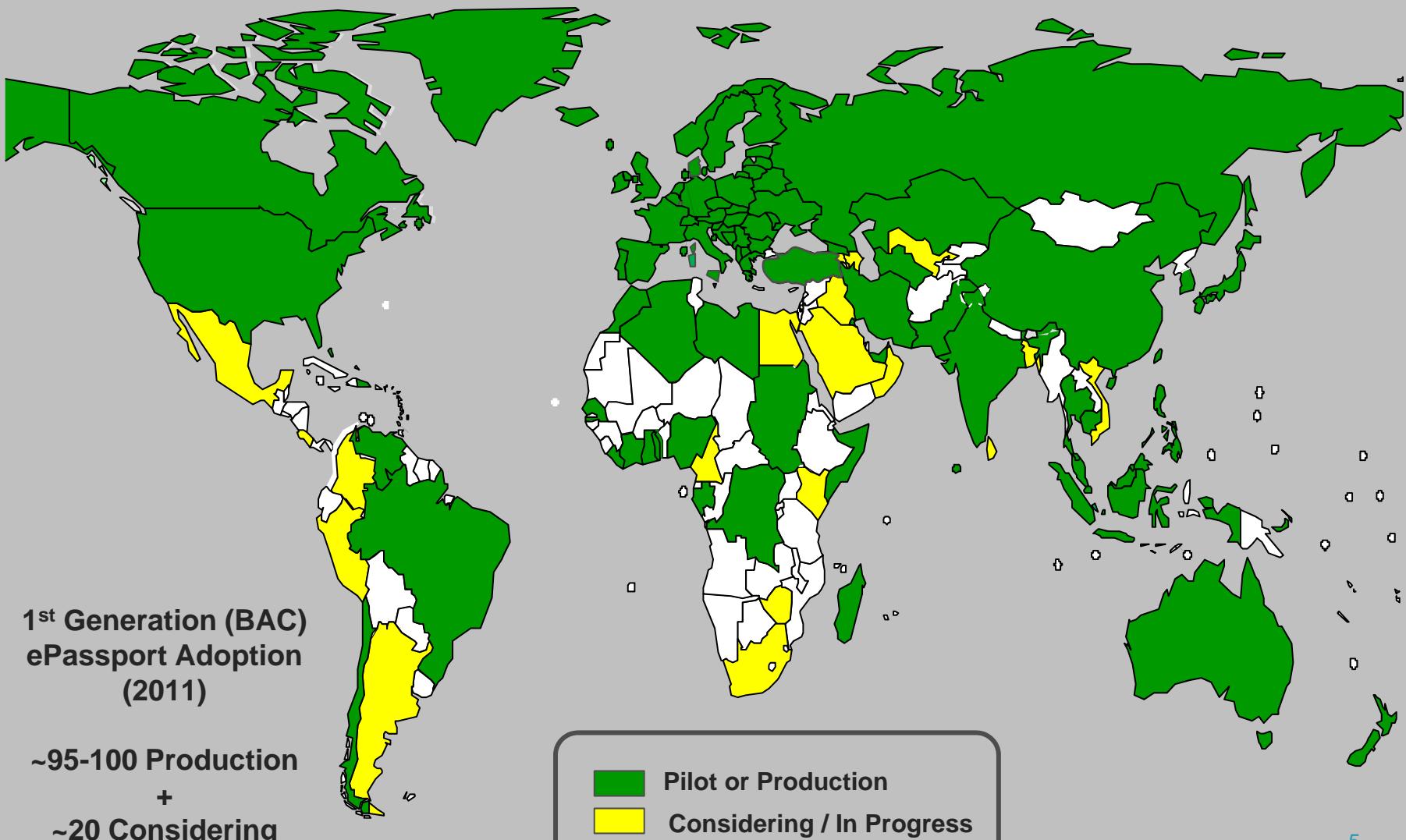


## BAC PKI Progression

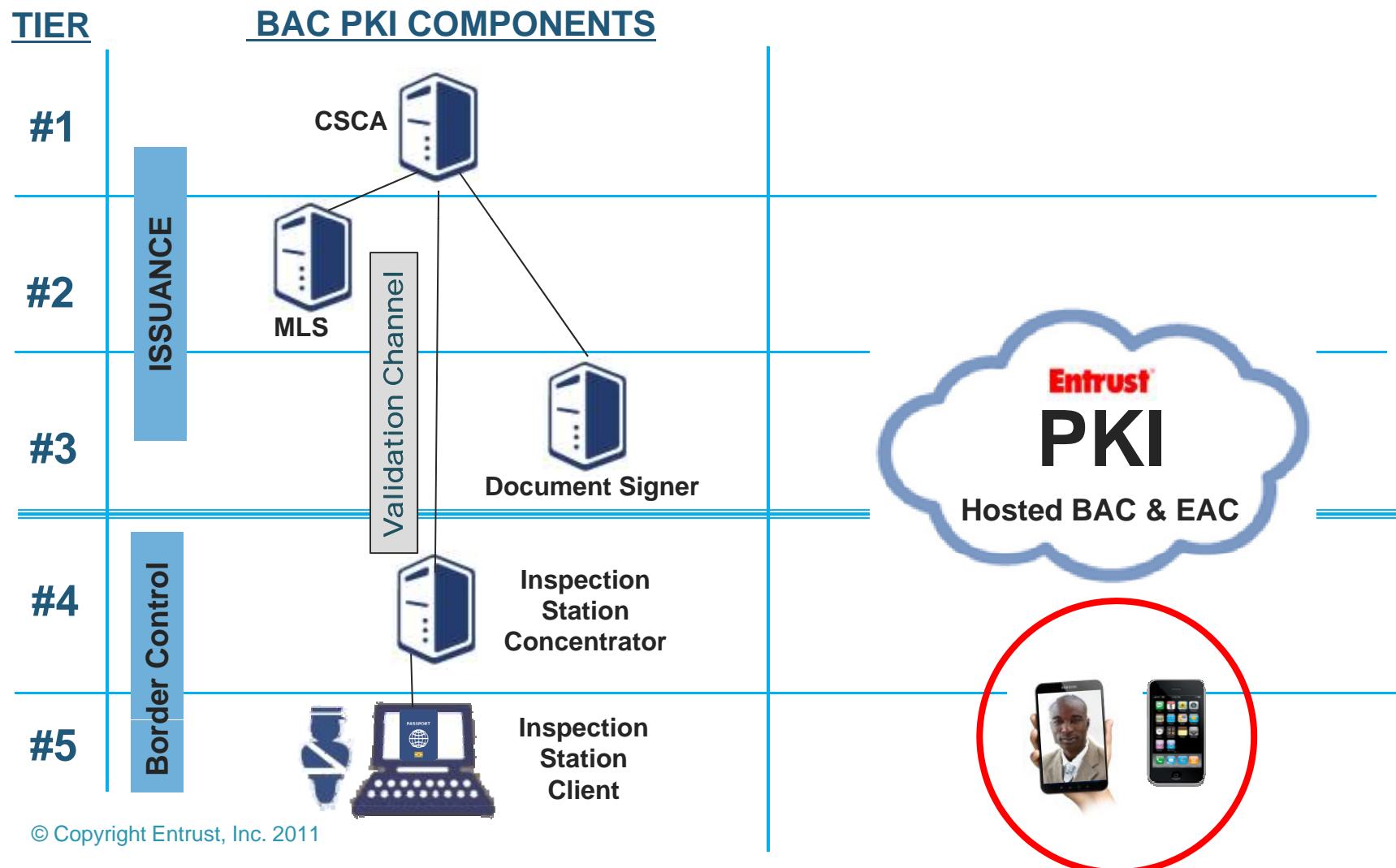


- 2006: ICAO 9303 Standards
- 2007: PKD deployment
  - ~27 countries, ~10 pending
- 2008: PKD Master List Signing (MLS)
- 2010: Validation channels
- 2011: Supplemental Access Control (SAC)
- **2012: *Cloud PKI / Mobile PKI***

# BAC: 5 Tier PKI Architecture

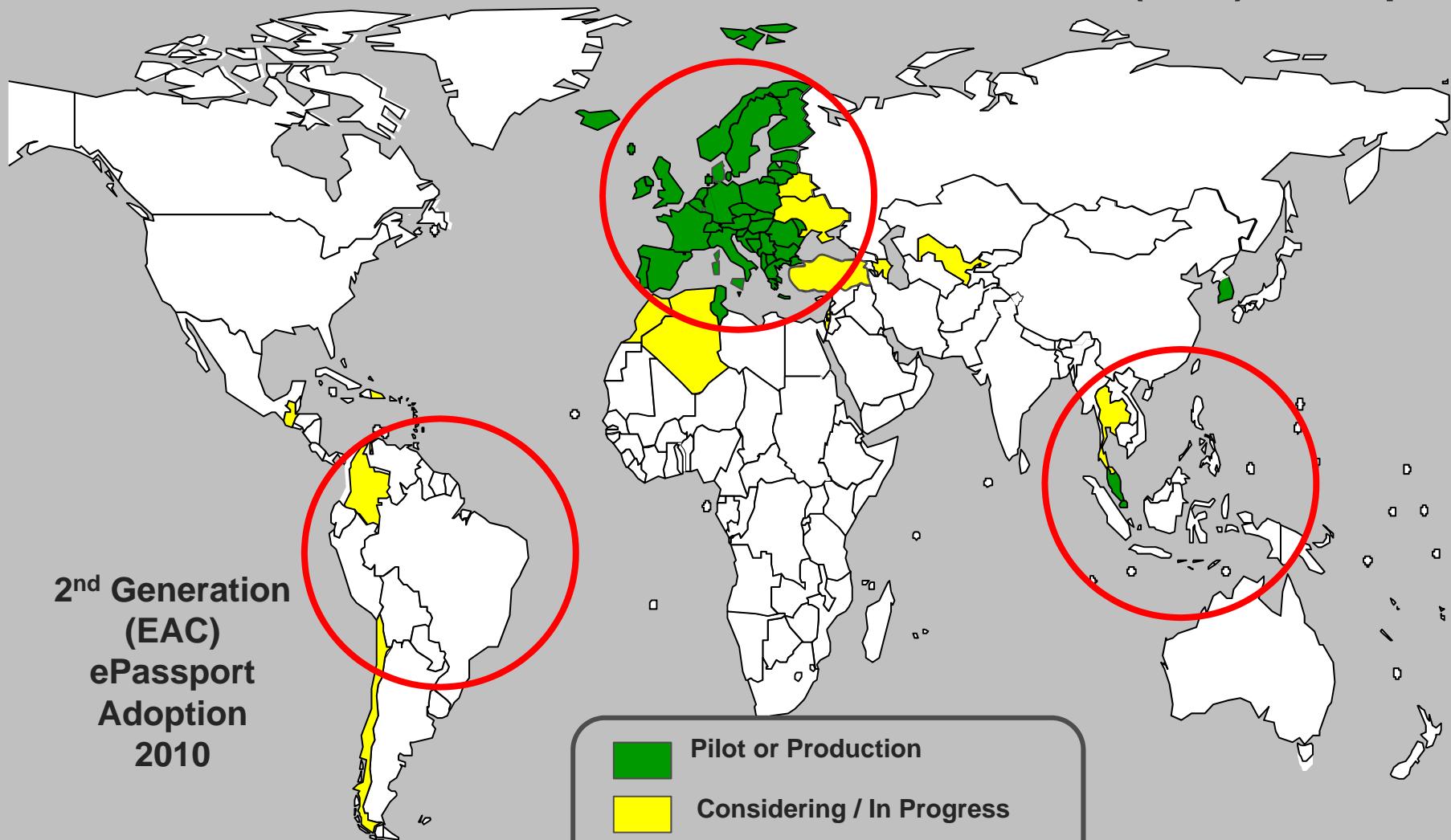


## EAC PKI Progression

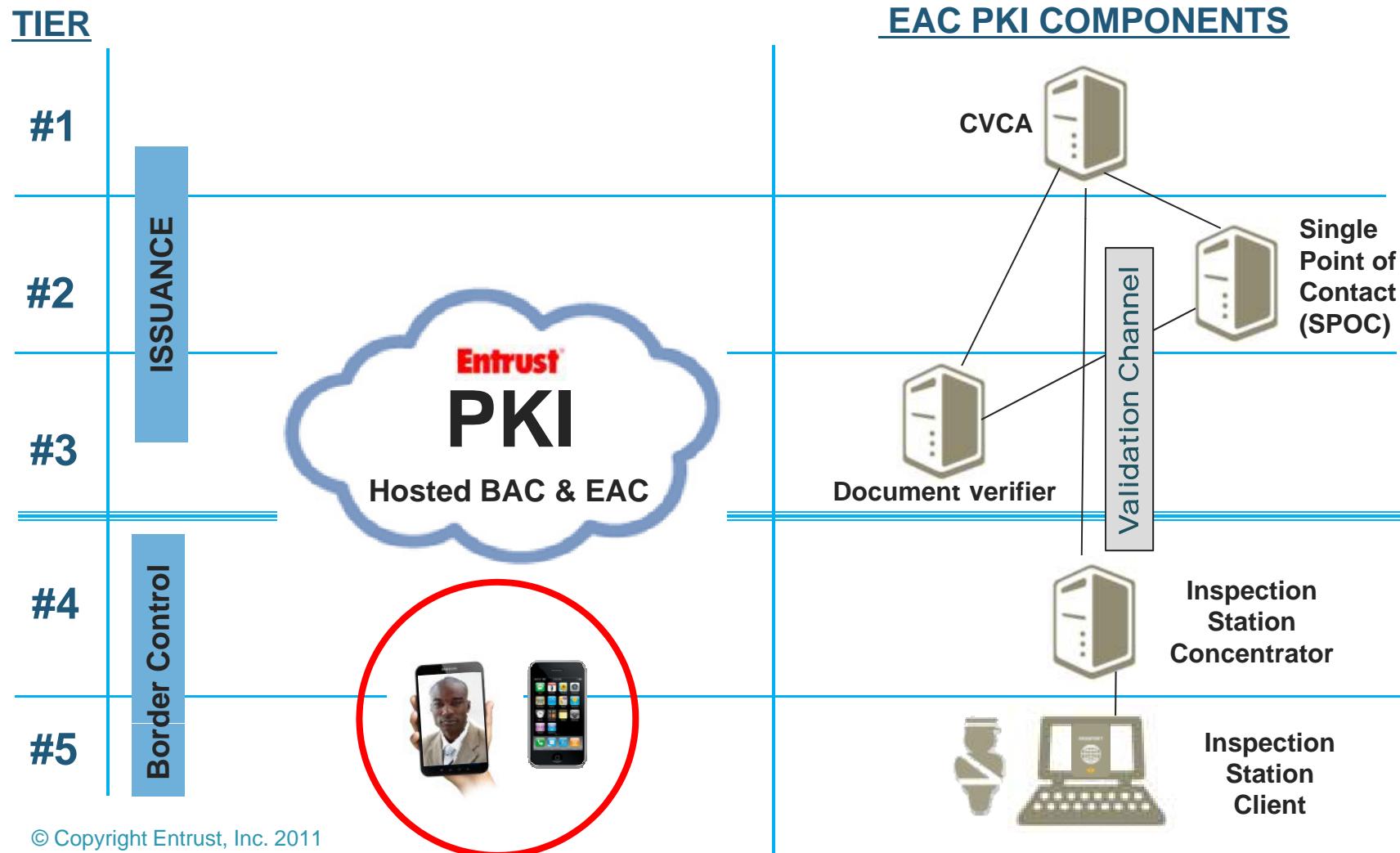


- 2006: EU EAC specification
- 2009: EU SPOC specification
- 2010: Validation channels

- 2011: Other applications (National ID smart cards)
- 2012: LDS 2.0, Border Control Optimization
- **2012: *Cloud PKI / Mobile PKI***

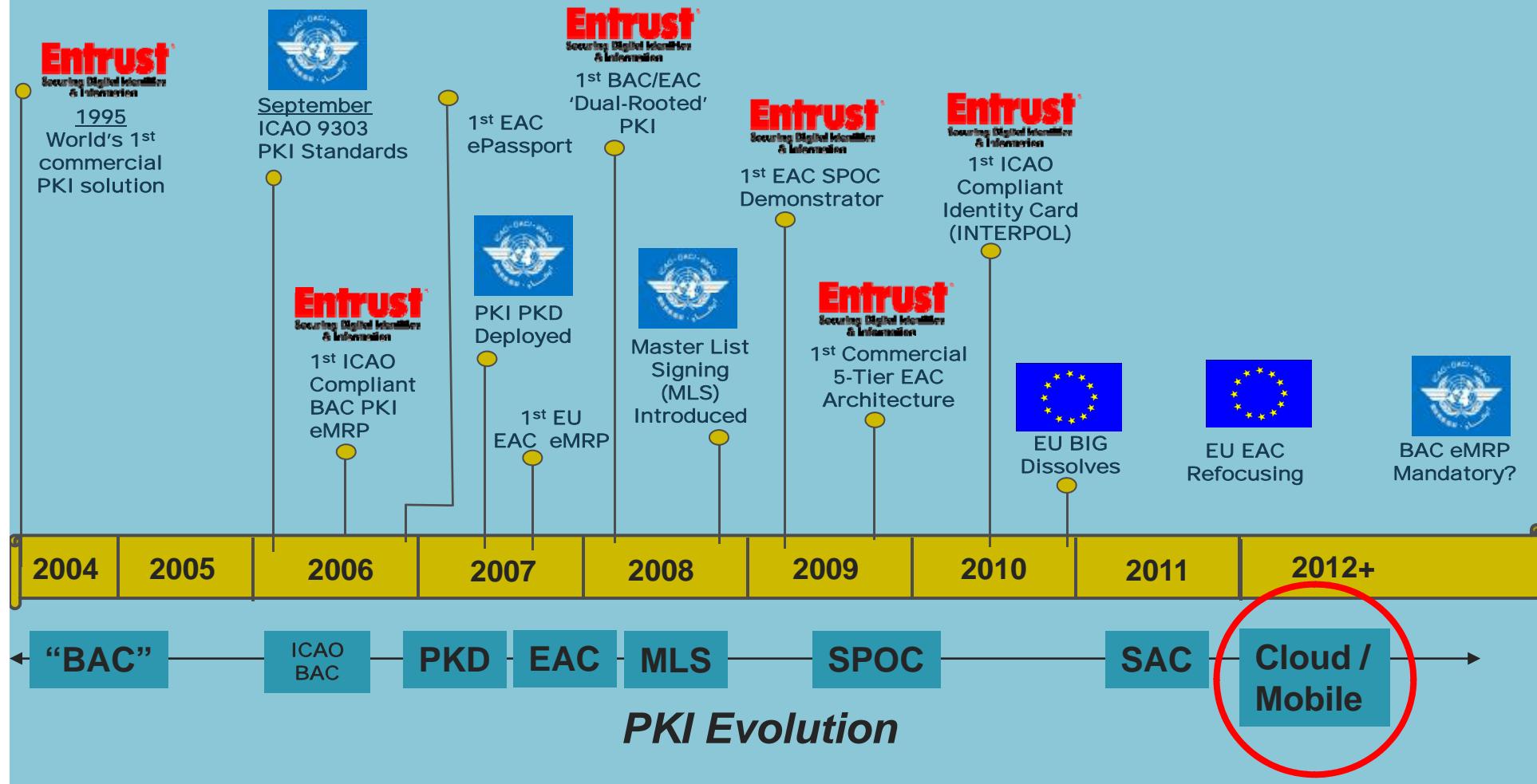


# EAC: 5 Tier PKI Architecture

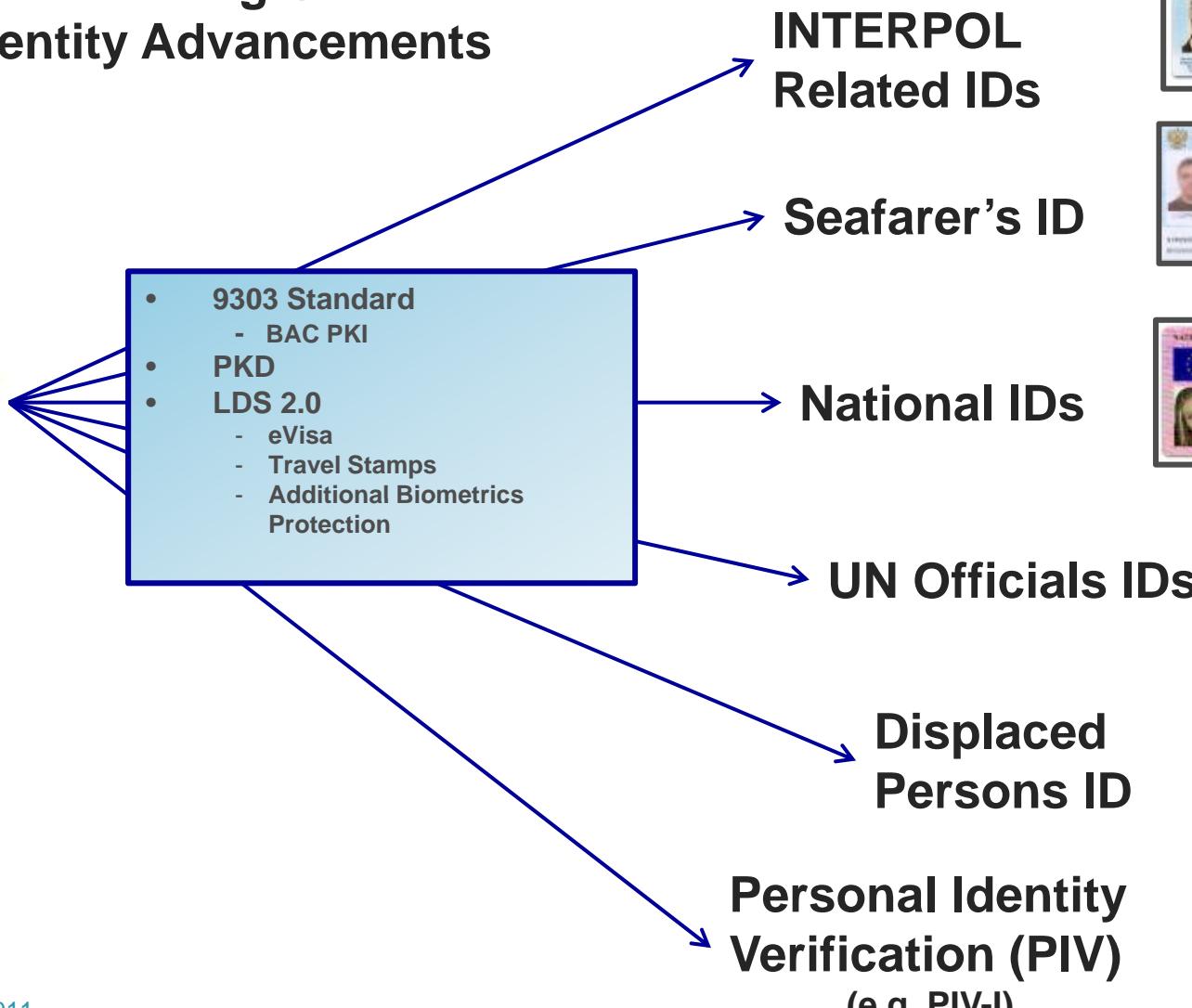


## The March of ePassport PKI

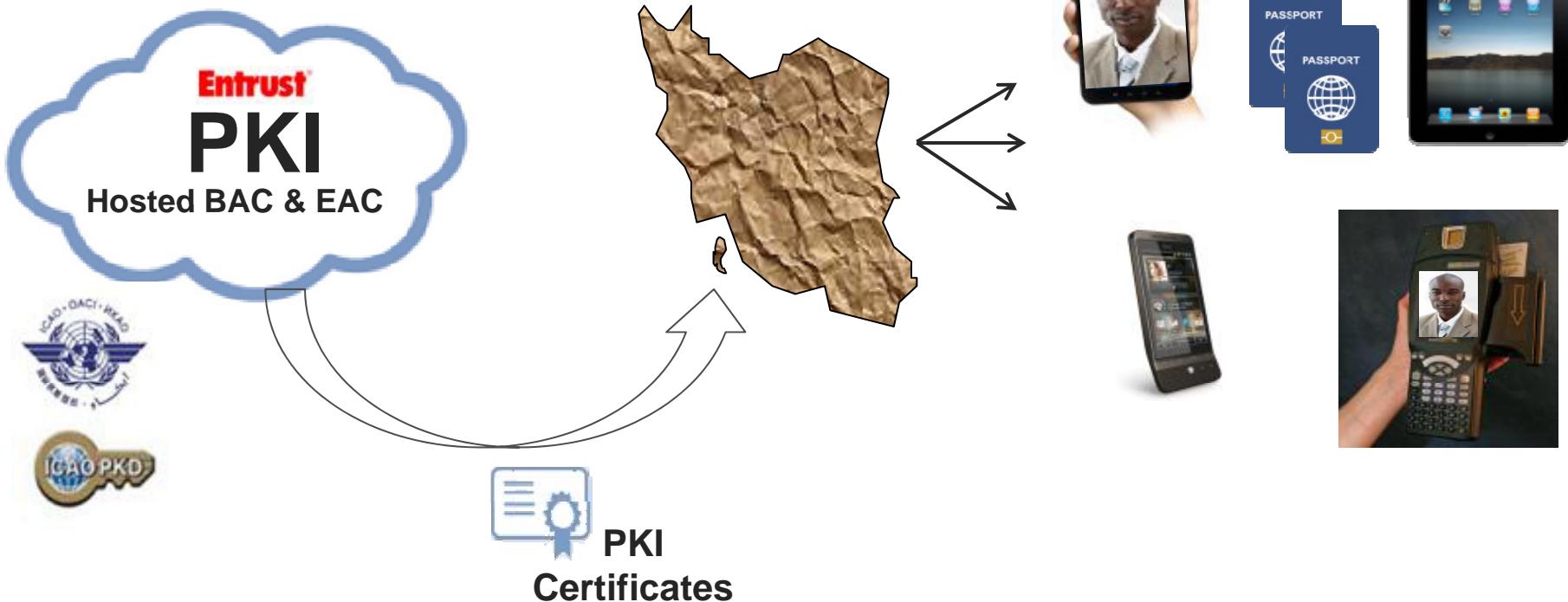
1995 – 2012+



## ICAO Efforts Influencing Global Travel and Identity Advancements

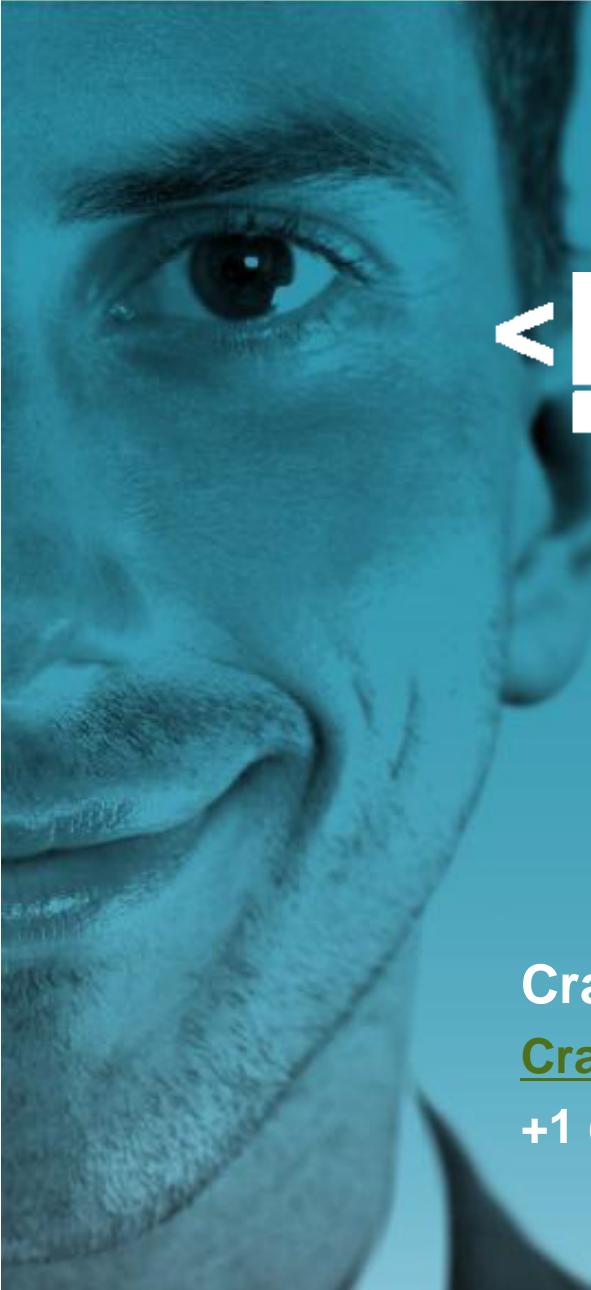
