















Traditional fraud

- Counterfeiting
- Forgery
- Blank stolen documents
- Impostors
- Fantasy documents








Counterfeiting

- Mostly one/two-sided documents;
- <u>Target</u>: the «key» which opens the most doors:
 - → least secure documents;
 - → regional visas;
 - → long existing documents.
- Trend: use of documents far away from the issuing country





















Forgery

- Mostly documents in booklet-format
- <u>Trends</u>:
 - manipulate (sand) one side
 of the document / datapage in
 order to retain the other side
 without damaging the security
 features;
 - glue a thin layer with new personal data.





Blank stolen documents

- Current biggest risk: countries in asymmetrical/civil war context
- Spring 2015: 9000 blank stolen passports in Libya – some already put in circulation
- 2014: 3800 blank stolen passports in Syria more than 90 of them in circulation
- Emergency passports stored in a safe in temporarily closed embassy.








Impostors

- Genuine and non-altered documents used by another person than the legitimate holder;
- Usually stolen/lost/sold passports;
- Trend: rental of travel documents.






