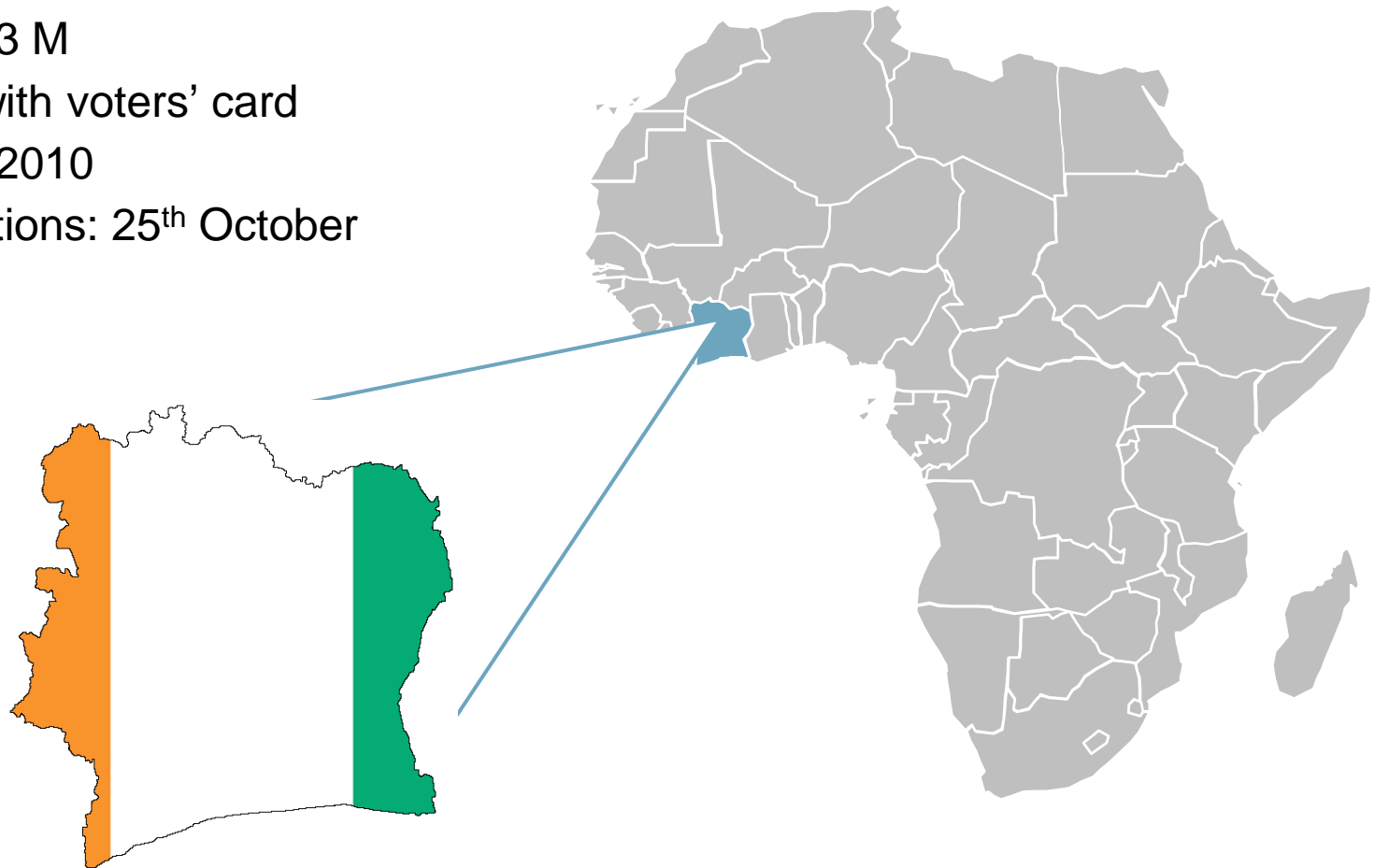

→ Côte d'Ivoire

- Population: 23.3 M
- Voters: 6.3 M with voters' card
- Last elections: 2010
- Upcoming elections: 25th October

CHALLENGE

→ Update existing voters' list

- Either those never registered
 - 10 fingerprints
 - Alphanumerical data
- Or those wanting to modify their data

→ Authenticate voters on the date of elections

- One polling station, one MorphoTablet

→ Transmit turnout and elections results in real time

- One polling station, one MorphoTablet

SOLUTION

→ A cost efficient, versatile tool...

- MorphoTablet fulfills different enrolment, authentication and identification needs
 - Elections
 - National identity
 - Police
 - Border control
- With or without biometrics
- Secure (encryption)

→ ... in line with realities of the ground

- Remote areas
- Harsh conditions (dust, power, connectivity, ...)



- Enrolment:
3,000 MorphoTablets
- Authentication on elections date:
22,000 MorphoTablets
in less than 2 months

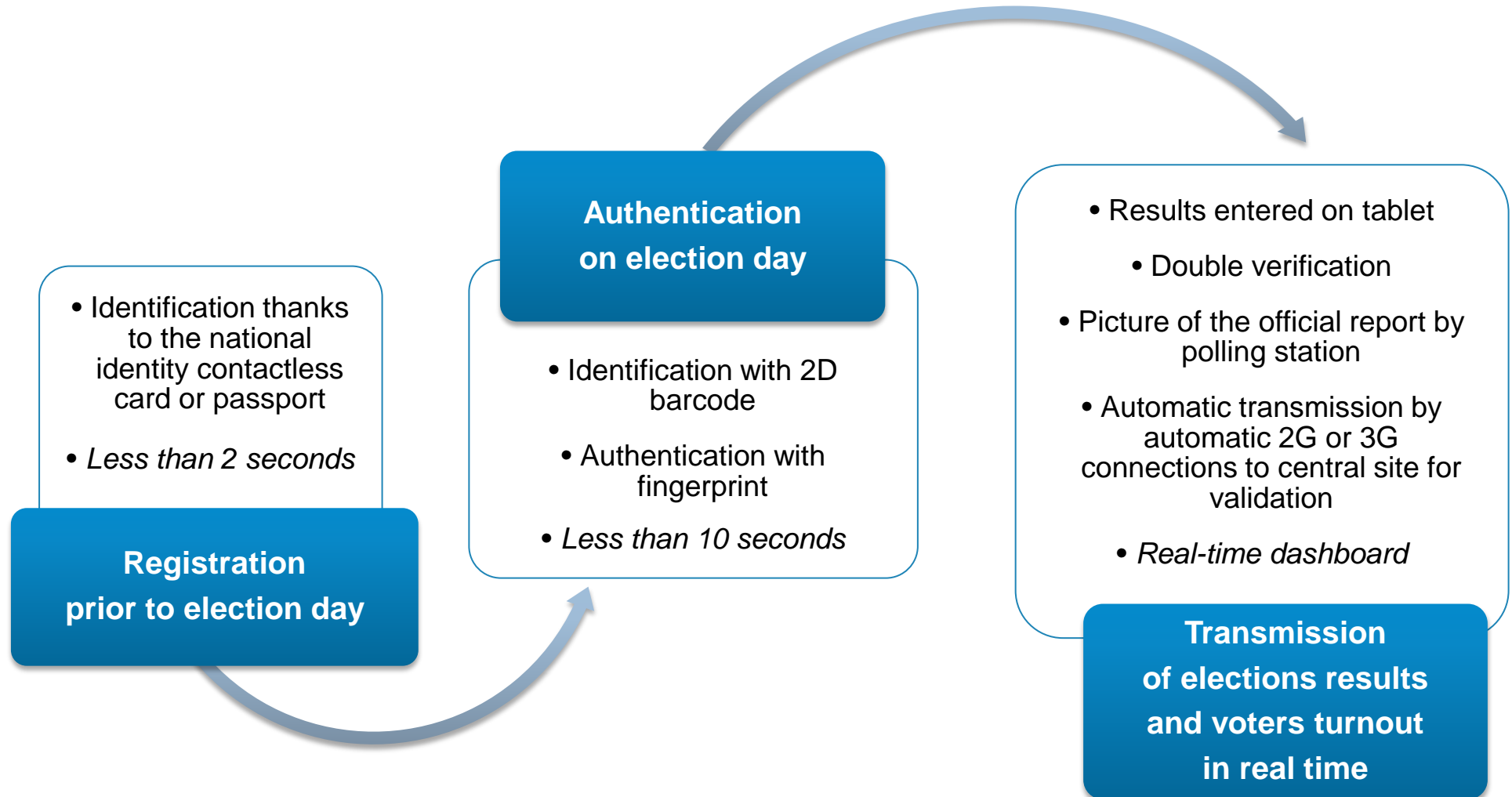

→ Ease of use

- Easy to carry, light
- Tactile tablet
- User-friendly

→ Portability

→ Secure

→ Two modes

- Online
- Offline to cater to remote areas without connectivity (use of USB or SD cards)

→ Power efficient

- Can last up to 2 shifts with its external battery

→ Re-use

- Other government entity can use the tablet for eID or passport control, birth declaration
