Key Points for airports:

- Importance of border crossing on passenger facilitation at airports.
- The role that airports and other industry players can play to contribute to a better and improved process
- Technology now provides opportunity to improve: Automated Border Clearance (ABC)
- Passengers are looking to have more choices, more control and for a more customized approach.
- Several options are starting to be deployed:
 - Examples: Nexus, Global entry, Canpass, APC, MPC and others
 - Registered options and others accessible to all
 - Bilateral agreements

Key Points for airports:

- Biometrics are now playing a key role
- Certain key factors are:
 - Having a harmonized approach
 - Interoperable equipment
 - Having common international standards
 - Keeping simplicity in the process
- Benefits to government authorities, airports, airlines and passengers ("Win" for all)
- Success requires collaboration
