ICAO TRIP Communication Platform

- A knowledge sharing website database platform that is :
 - currently in Beta testing pilot stage
 - for exchanging general, as well as, technical information on travel documents and Border Control from various States,
 - only accessible for authorised authorities:
 - ICAO member States;
 - International Organizations; and
 - other travel document issuing entities/authorities

Background

- The work implemented by the TAG/MRTD heavily relies on States' resources, and uses internet-based communications to achieve most of its work.
- Currently, the web sites supporting these activities are not integrated nor fully functional.
- The exchange of relevant information is a basic resource for travel document issuing authorities.
- The necessity of having a web-based platform for a secured exchange of information, expertise and knowledge is necessary and timely.

Objectives

- To provide the TAG/MRTD and its working groups a robust, integrated and sustainable platform to support its work;
- To provide a worldwide network for effective and efficient communication among users.
- To assist officials who work with travel documents to broaden their knowledge.
- To be a worldwide single point of reference for technical information on all travel documents and Border Control issues.
- To share documents, experiences, best practices etc. on secure and reliable information, via the website.
