1. BRIEF REVIEW OF WORK DONE ON TUESDAY, 25 NOVEMBER 2008

1.1 The Efficiency Committee met at 0930 hours and elected Mr. Chitalu Kabalinka (Zambia) as its Chairman. It also elected Mr. Sama Juma Ignatius (Cameroon) as its Vice-Chairman.

1.2 The Efficiency Committee held its first plenary meeting and reviewed WPs 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, Rev. No.1, 13, 33, 41, 44, 52, 53, 65, 66, 67, 69, 71, 72 and 73. It also reviewed the *Directives to Regional Air Navigation Meetings and Rules of Procedure for their Conduct* (Doc 8144). The Efficiency Committee made exceptional progress and developed recommendations on reduced vertical separation minima (RVSM) safety monitoring, performance-based navigation (PBN), implementation of the new ICAO flight plan and implementation of ATS routes.

1.3 The Safety Committee held its first plenary meeting and elected Mrs. Sanogo Téné Isaabre (Mali) as its Chairperson and Mr. Mumtaz Hussein R. Alloo (Tanzania) as its Vice-Chairman. The Committee reviewed WPs 24, 26, 17, 37, 63, 60, 47, Revision No. 1, 23 and 29 as well as the *Directives to Regional Air Navigation Meetings and Rules of Procedure for their Conduct* (Doc 8144). The Safety Committee made recommendations on the establishment of regional accident investigation organizations and the further development of regional safety oversight

2. PROGRAMME OF WORK FOR WEDNESDAY, 26 NOVEMBER 2008

2.1 The Efficiency Committee will meet as a working group of the whole to continue its discussions on WPs 12, Rev. No. 1, 53 and 73. It will also review WPs 8, 18, 20, 21, 39, 40, 46, 51, 54, Corr No. 1, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 67, 68 and 74. The Efficiency Committee will, as a working group of the whole, continue its discussions on Agenda Item 6 – Development of a set of comprehensive work programmes in the air navigation field, aimed at improving efficiency of the air navigation system.

2.2 The Safety Committee will meet as a working group of the whole and review WPs 16 Revision No. 1, 61, 64, 50, 48, 49, 30, 38, 45, 28, 77 and 35. The Committee will, as a working group of the whole, continue its discussions on Agenda Item 5 – Development of a set of comprehensive work programmes in the safety field.
